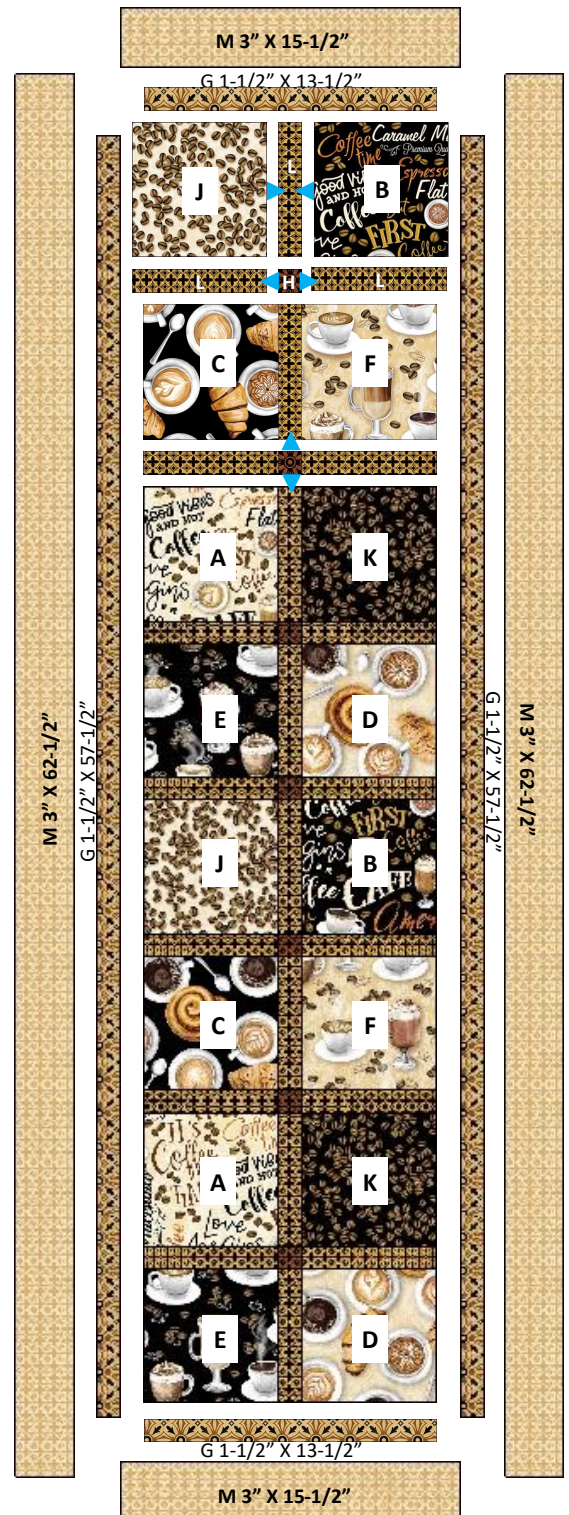


## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric | \*Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

	<b>COFFEE GEO</b> <b>L</b> 14161-72 Caramel	1/3 YD	(4) 1-1/2" X WOF strips, subcut (22) 1-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangles
	<b>COFFEE GEO</b> <b>M</b> 14161-73 Toast	5/8 YD	(5) 3" X WOF strips *, <b>BORDER 2</b>

### DIAGRAM



**RUNNER ASSEMBLY:** Refer to **DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

1. Sew pieces together as indicated in diagram into rows, then sew rows together.

**BORDER ASSEMBLY:** Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.

2. Sew (1) G 1-1/2" X (13-1/2") strip to top and bottom, then sew (1) G 1-1/2" X (57-1/2") strip to each side.
3. Sew (1) M 3" X (15-1/2") strip to top and bottom, then sew (1) M 3" X (62-1/2") strip to each side.

### FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with H fabric.
