WOF = Width of fabric | LOF = Length of fabric | \*Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

# **BLOCK ASSEMBLY:** Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAMS**

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of J 1-1/2" squares.
- 2. Sew 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" J pieces to opposite sides of a 4-1/2" D square to make DJ UNIT. Make (15).
- 3. Place (1) J square right sides together on the each end of (1) C 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn lines, then trim 1/4" past the lines and press open to make CJ UNIT. Make (30).
- 4. Sew (1) CJ UNIT to top and bottom of (1) DJ UNIT to make BLOCK 1A. Square to 6-1/2", make 15.
- 5. Repeat steps 2-4 to make a total of 15 **BLOCK 1B** using the fabrics shown.





**DJ UNIT** (make 15)






CJ UNIT (make 30)

**QUILT ASSEMBLY:** Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

6. Sew (1) **G** 2-1/2" X 42-1/2" strip to each side of the 23-1/2" X 42-1/2" **A** panel. Sew (1) **G** 2" X 27-1/2" strip to top and bottom of the panel. Panel should measure 27-1/2" X 45-1/2".

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.

Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

- 7. Sew (1) J 2" X (45-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt center. Sew (1) J 2" X (30-1/2") strip to top and bottom.
- 8. Sew (4) each **BLOCK 1A** and **1B** into a vertical block row. Make (2). Sew to each side of the quilt center. Sew (4) **BLOCK 1A** and (3) **BLOCK 1B** together to make the horizontal top row. Sew (4) **BLOCK 1B** and (3) **BLOCK 1A** together to make the horizontal bottom row. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
- 9. Sew (1) J 2" X (60-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt. Sew (1) J 2" X (45-1/2") strip to top and bottom.
- 10. Sew (1)  $\mathbf{H} 4 1/2^n \times (63 1/2^n)$  strip to each side of the quilt. Sew (1)  $\mathbf{H} 4 1/2^n \times (53 1/2^n)$  strip to top and bottom.

### **FINISHING:**

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **F** fabric.
