Fussy cut (1) $34-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, centered on the panel.
(2) 4 " $\times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
(6) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.*
(8) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, BINDING.
(1) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares.
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3-1/2" squares.
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut (8) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut (24) 3-1/2" squares.
(2) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (12) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3-1/2" squares.
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips.
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut (24) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
(2) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(2) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
(2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Subcut (8) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

(2) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 64-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strips.
From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 67-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

[^0]BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2"X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

## Note: The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) B

3-1/2" x 42-1/2" strip to each side of the A $34-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 42-1/2" rectangle. Sew (1) B $4^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the $\mathbf{A}$ rectangle to make the Center Block. Trim the block to measure

2. Place (1) D $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on the top left corner of (1) C 6-1/2" square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the sewn seam.

3. Follow the diagram below for the seam direction to add a D 3-1/2" square to each of the remaining corners of the $\mathbf{C} 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to make (1) Unit 1 square.
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.

5. Place (1) E $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on the left side of (1) D $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.

6. Place another $\mathbf{E} 3-1 / 2$ " square on the right side of the D 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip.
7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make (8) Unit 2 strips total.

8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to the diagrams for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make the indicated number of each unit strip for Unit 3 through Unit 9.

9. Follow the diagram and sew together (16) assorted unit strips lengthwise to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.

10. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square, (6) assorted unit strips, (1) J 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip, (6) assorted unit strips and (1) Unit 1 square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

Top/Bottom Border make 2


Quilt Assembly
11. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
12. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE B AND K BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.
13. Sew (1) B $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times\left(60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) B 2-1/2" x (55-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) $\mathrm{K} 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}\left(64-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) K 6-1/2" x ( $67-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 67" x 76"
