WOF = Width of fabric | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

| F | SUPERIOR SOLIDS 3000B-52 Water | 1/2 YD | (1) 9-1/4" x WOF strips, subcut (4) 9-1/4" squares (2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips, subcut (24) 2-7/8" squares |
| G | SUPERIOR SOLIDS 3000B-71 Light Khaki | 1/2 YD | (1) 9-1/4" x WOF strips, subcut (4) 9-1/4" squares (2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips, subcut (24) 2-7/8" squares |
| Н | SUPERIOR SOLIDS 3000B-74 Vanilla | 1/2 YD | (1) 9-1/4" x WOF strips, subcut (4) 9-1/4" squares (2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips, subcut (24) 2-7/8" squares |

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

- 1. Pair the cuts of (2) A print fabrics with (1) D through H solid for a total of 5 piles. Each block will have only two fabrics, a print and a solid.
- 2. Cut all the 2-7/8" squares in half diagonally. Diagram 1
- 3. Sew a solid triangle to (8) of each print 3-3/8" square, these are the corners. There will be (2) 3-3/8" squares of each print leftover for the centers. Diagram 2
- 4. Sew (2) print triangles with (2) solid triangles for a quarter square triangle unit. Make 8 in each color combination for a total of 80. Diagram 3

BLOCK ASSEMBLY (continued):

- 5. Sew a corner unit to each quarter square triangle unit on the solid fabric side. Diagram 4
- 6. Sew (2) diagram 4 units to opposite sides of the remaining 3-3/8" squares. Diagram 5
- 7. Cut the 9-1/4" squares in half diagonally twice. Diagram 6
- Sew (2) 9-1/4" triangles to the sides of the remaining diagram 4 units as shown. Diagram 7
- 9. Sew (2) diagram 7 units to opposite sides of each diagram 5 unit to complete a 12-1/2" block. Diagram 8
- 10. Layout the blocks into 5 rows of 4 blocks each according to the quilt diagram.



QUILT ASSEMBLY:

- 11. Sew into rows and sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.
- 12. Sew the 1-1/2" **B** strips together end to end for the inner borders.

BORDER ASSEMBLY:

Note: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.

- 13. Cut (2) B 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" and sew to the long sides of the quilt.
- 14. Cut (2) B 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- 15. Sew the 3-1/2" C strips together end to end for the outer borders.
- 16. Cut (2) C 3-1/2" x 62-1/2" and sew to the long sides of the quilt.
- 17. Cut (2) C 3-1/2" x 56-1/2" and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt to complete the quilt top..

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with C fabric.
