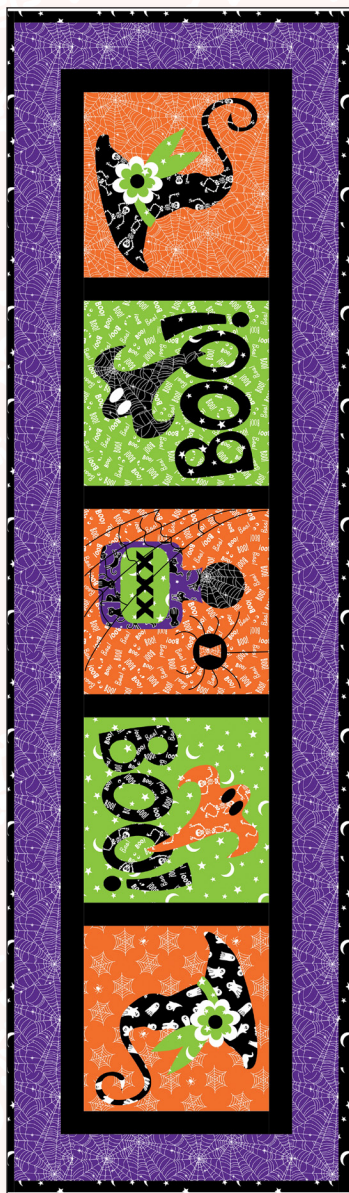





Ravenous Rachel's Runner

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern
 ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED: Heat n Bond Lite Iron-on Adhesive or Heat n Bond Lite EZ Print Sheets

	D SAY BOO 14561G-44 Green	1 FQ	(1) 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" square Applique: (1) small flower, (1) hat band
	E WEBBY 14562G-12 Black	1 FQ	Applique: (1) Potion bottle top and (1) ghost
	F WEBBY 14562G-38 Orange	1 FQ	(1) 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" square Applique: (1) Spider hourglass

Applique Tip #1:

When putting together your applique pieces, lay them out first before ironing to your fabric. Make sure they slightly overlap if indicated in the keys. A heatproof sheet is a great tool for assembling the pieces. Lay them out on the sheet and lightly press them in place (do not do it for too long.) Let cool. Carefully peel off the applique from the sheet and lay it on the right side of your background fabric. Press in place.

Applique Tip #2:

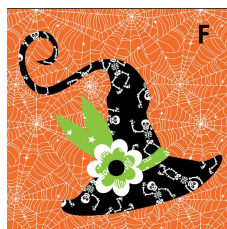
Ironing a lightweight interfacing on the back of applique blocks adds stability when stitching around fabric pieces.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: *Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS and BLOCK KEYS*

1. Trace applique designs on smooth side of iron-on adhesive. Be sure to write the name of piece on traced designs. Designs are reversed so they will be the correct direction when ironed on fabrics.
2. Cut around traced applique designs leaving at least a quarter inch from solid line. Iron applique designs (rough side down) to wrong side of fabrics following package directions. Let cool.
3. Cut out applique pieces on solid lines. Peel off paper liner from the backs of applique pieces. Place applique, adhesive side down, on right side of C, D, F, J and N 8-1/2" squares. Press according to package directions until entire piece is bonded. Let cool.
4. Sew around applique design edges using a straight, zig-zag, or blanket stitch. For Block 3, Embroider spider legs and web by hand or machine using Embroidery Key.

RUNNER ASSEMBLY: *Refer to RUNNER DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.*

5. Sew (6) Q 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips and BLOCKS together.
6. Measure length of runner (ours is 46-1/2"). Cut (2) Q 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of runner.

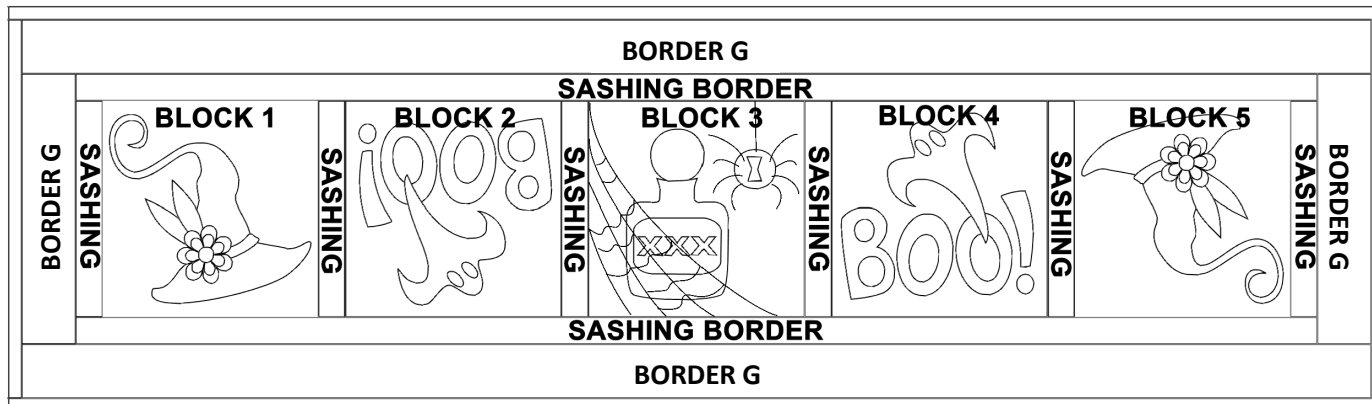
BORDER ASSEMBLY: *Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements. Refer to RUNNER DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.*

7. Sew (1) G 2-1/2" x (10-1/2") strips to each side, then sew (1) G 2-1/2" x (50-1/2") strip to top and bottom.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with H fabric.

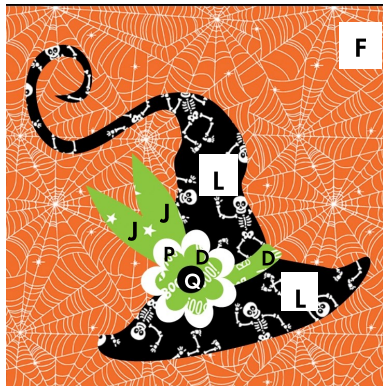

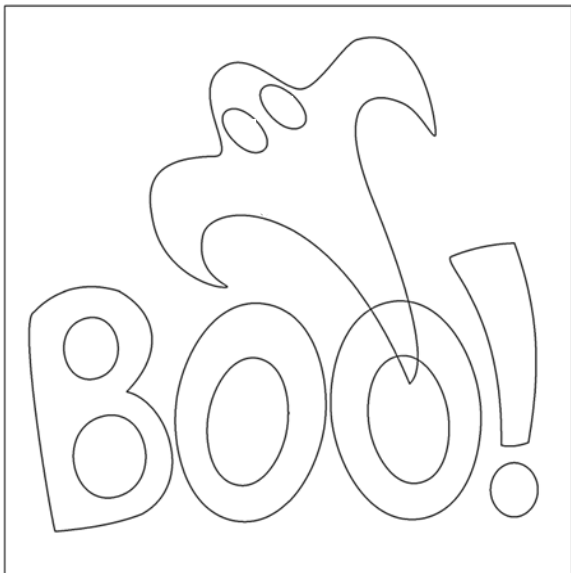

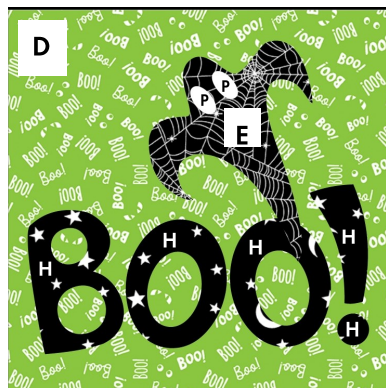


BOO —APPLIQUE KEY

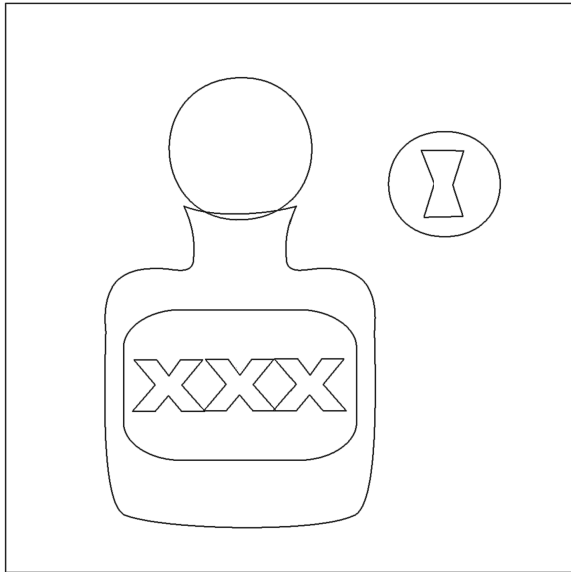

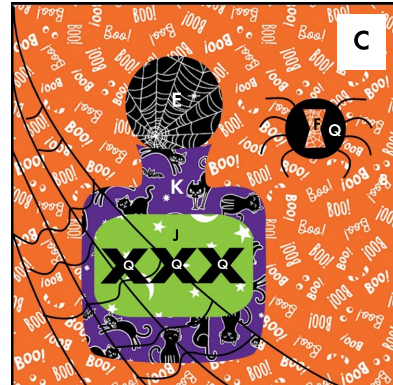

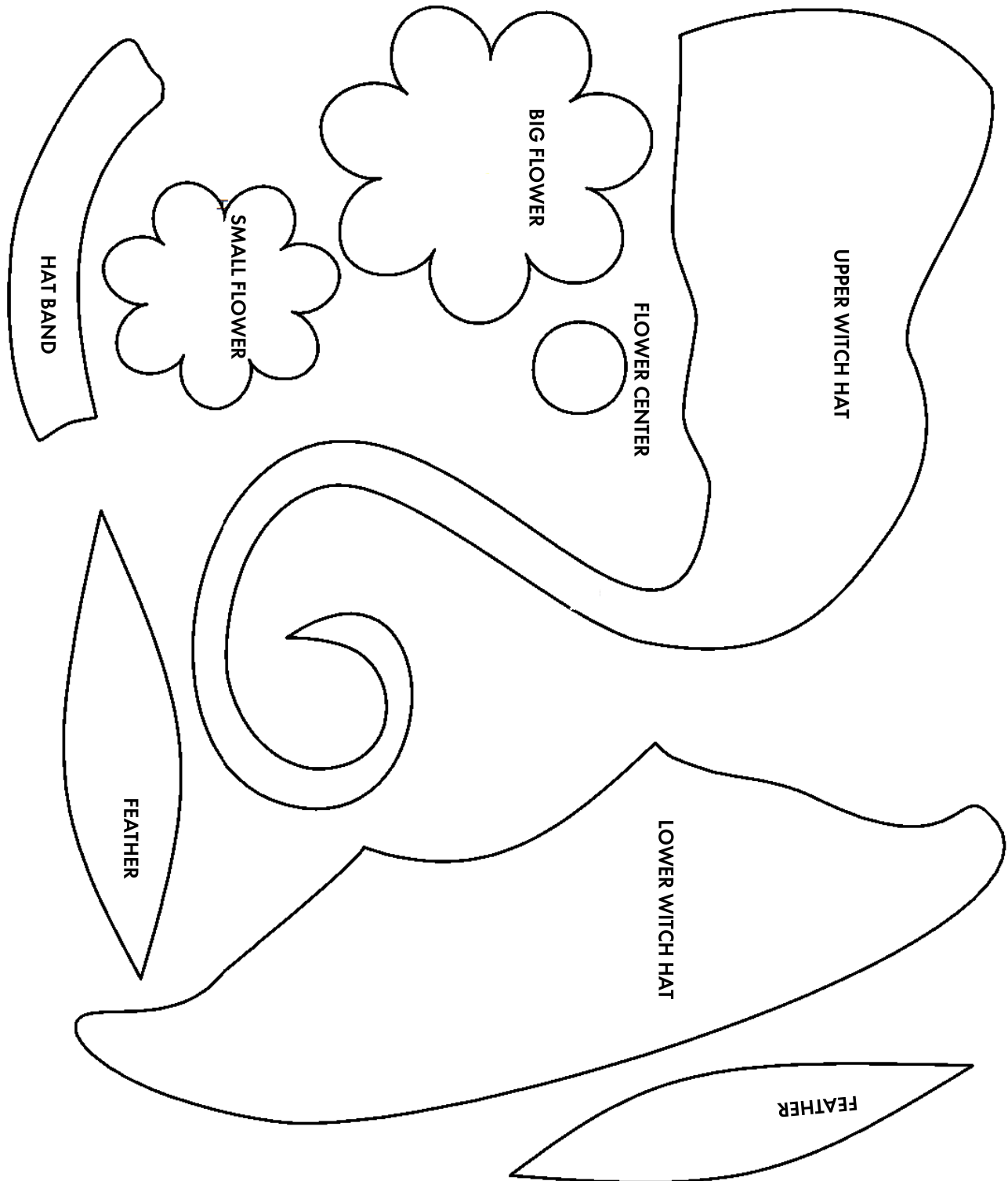

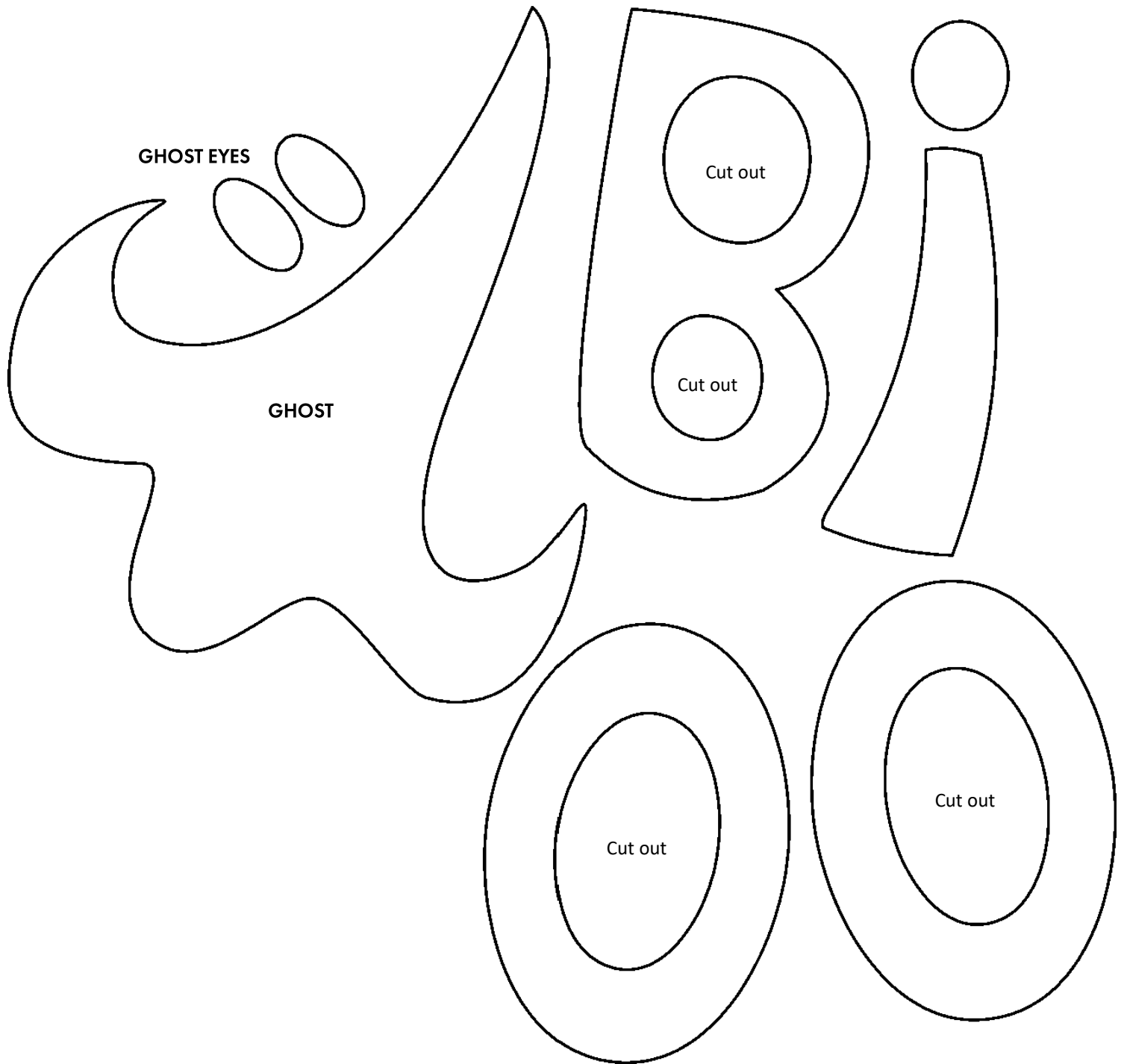

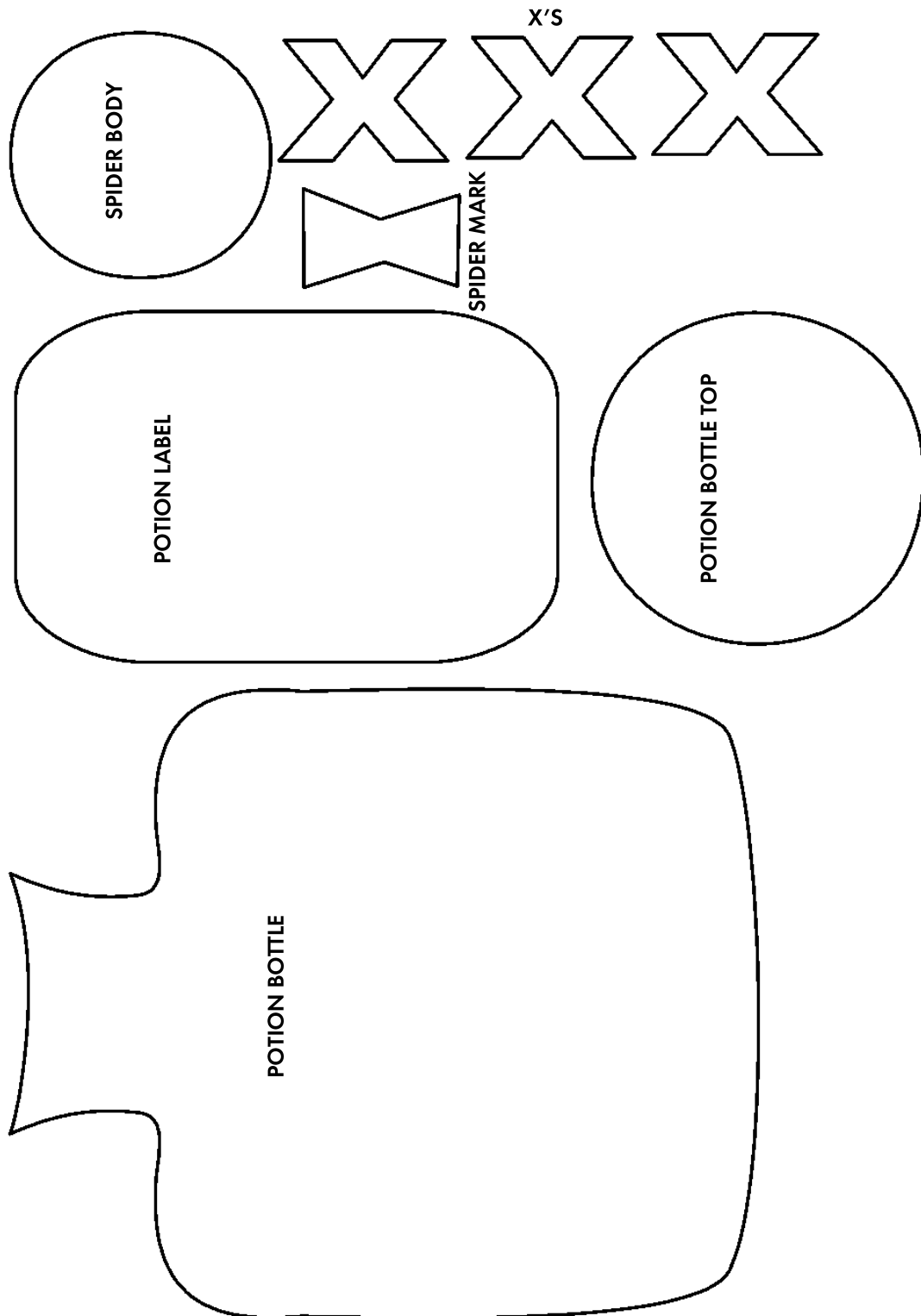
