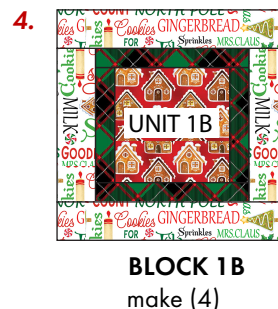
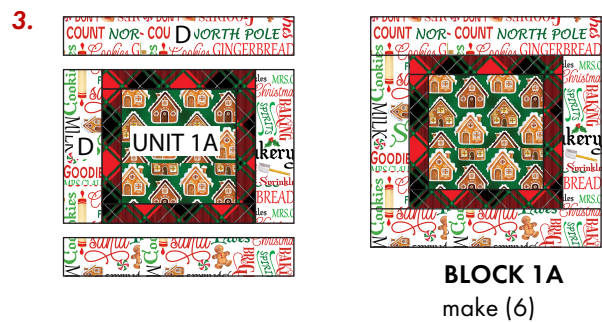
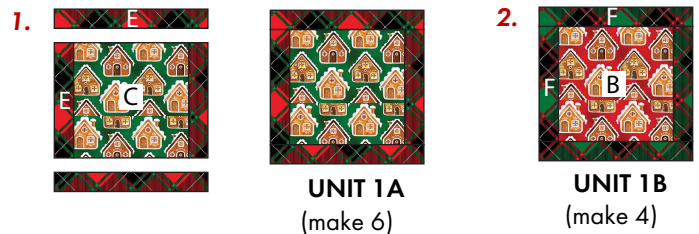
WOF = Width of fabric | LOF = Length of fabric | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- Sew **E** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to opposite sides of (1) **C** 6-1/2" square. Sew **E** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom to make **UNIT 1A**, measuring 8-1/2" square. Make 6.
- Sew **F** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to opposite sides of (1) **B** 6-1/2" square. Sew **F** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom to make **UNIT 1B**, measuring 8-1/2" square. Make 4.
- Sew **D** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles to opposite sides of (1) **UNIT 1A**. Sew **D** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom to make **BLOCK 1A**, measuring 12-1/2" square. Make 6.
- Sew **D** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles to opposite sides of (1) **UNIT 1B**. Sew **D** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom to make **BLOCK 1B**, measuring 12-1/2" square. Make 4.

BLOCK DIAGRAMS



5. Sew **J** 2" x 9-1/2" rectangles to opposite sides of (1) **G** 9-1/2" square. Sew **J** 2" x 12-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom to make **BLOCK 2A**, measuring 12-1/2" square. Make 6.
6. Sew **J** 2" x 9-1/2" rectangles to opposite sides of (1) **K** 9-1/2" square. Sew **J** 2" x 12-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom to make **BLOCK 2B**, measuring 12-1/2" square. Make 4.

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

7. Lay out the blocks into (5) rows of (4) blocks each as follows:
BLOCK 1A - BLOCK 2A - BLOCK 1A - BLOCK 2A
BLOCK 2B - BLOCK 1B - BLOCK 2B - BLOCK 1B
BLOCK 1A - BLOCK 2A - BLOCK 1A - BLOCK 2A
BLOCK 2B - BLOCK 1B - BLOCK 2B - BLOCK 1B
BLOCK 1A - BLOCK 2A - BLOCK 1A - BLOCK 2A
8. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows to complete the quilt center.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.

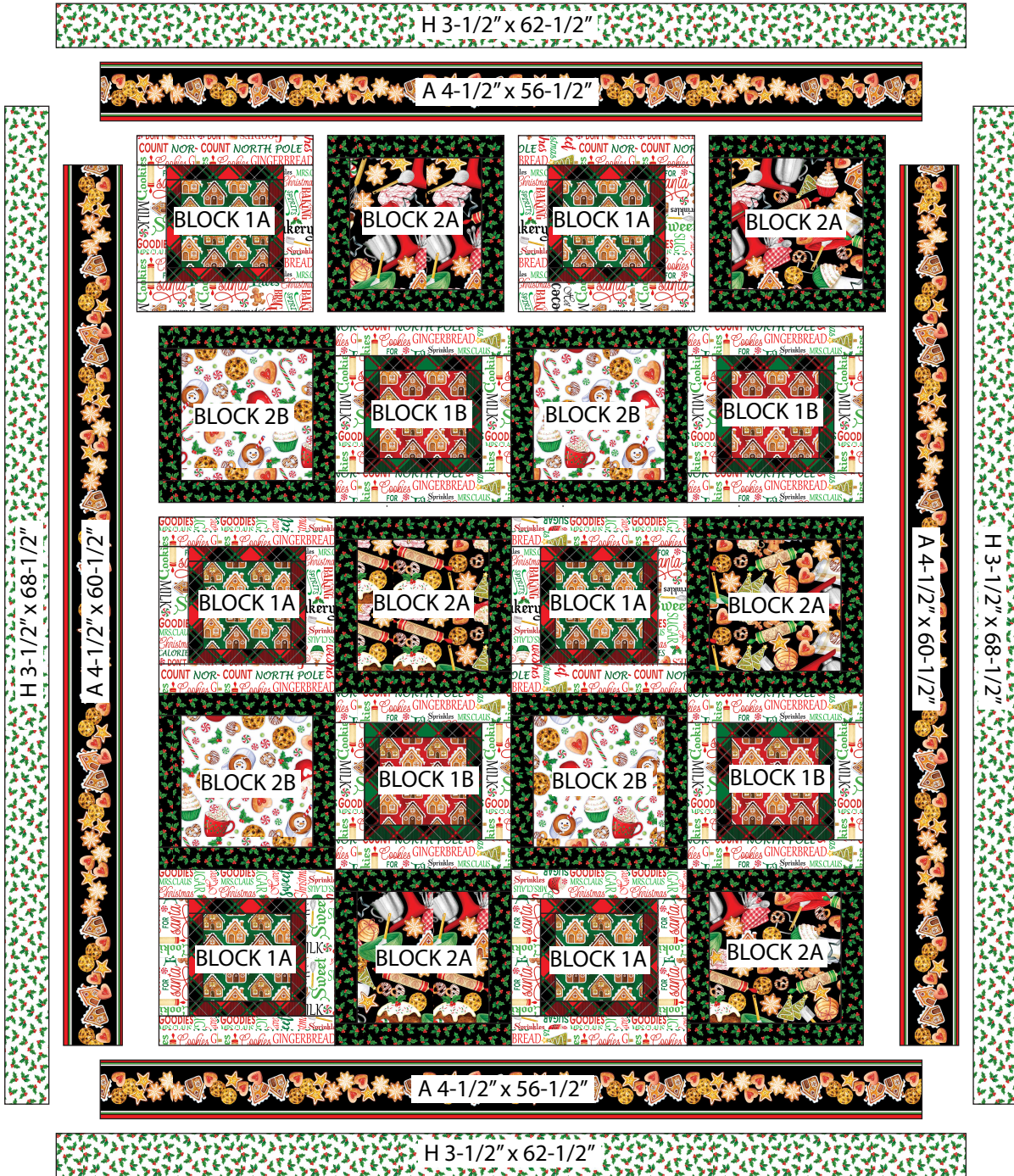
Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

9. Sew **A** 4-1/2" x (60-1/2") strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew **A** 4-1/2" x (56-1/2") strips to the top and bottom.
10. Sew **H** 3-1/2" x (68-1/2") strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew **H** 3-1/2" x (62-1/2") strips to the top and bottom

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **F** fabric.
