## Half Square Triangles (HST)

For best results, sew a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on diagonal seams.

1. Place (1) C 3 3/8" square and (1) E $33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square with RST and draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of line. Cut on line and open to make (2) CE-HST. Square to $3^{\prime \prime}$. Make 15 CE-HST.

2. Use step 1 instructions to make (15) CG-HST

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

## Block 1

3. Sew (1) CE-HST to right side of (1) E $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ piece, press to make CE set. Sew (1) D $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " piece to bottom of (1) CE set just made to make CED set.
4. Sew (1) CED set to left side of (1) C 5 " x $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " piece, press to make CEDC set. Repeat to make (15) CEDC sets.
5. Sew (1) A 7" x 3 " to (1) B 7" x 9" to make (1) AB set. Repeat to make (15) AB sets.
6. Sew (1) AB set to top of (1) CEDC set to make Block \#1. Make (15) Block \#1.



## Block 2

7. Sew (1) CG-HST to top of (1) G 3 " $\times 21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ piece to make (1) CG set. Sew (1)E $4^{1 / 2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ piece to left side of CG set just made to make CGE set.
8. Sew (1) CGE set to top of (1) H 7" square to make CGEH set. Sew (1) F $11 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ piece to left side of CGEH set just made to make (1) Block \#2. Make (15) Block \#2.


## QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Refer to quilt diagram for placement and rotation of blocks. Sew blocks together to make each row.
9. Odd rows - Rows $1,3 \& 5$

Sew (3) Block \#1 and (2) Block \#2 alternately starting with Block \#1

## 10. Even rows - Rows 2,4 \& 6

Sew (3) Block \#2 and (2) Block \#1 alternately starting with Block \#2
11. Sew Rows together in order, 1 being at the top and 6 at the bottom to make quilt center.

BORDERS:
12. Sew (2) I $1 \frac{1}{1} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips together at short ends. Sew to left and right side of quilt center. Press and trim even with quilt center.
13. Sew (2) I $1 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips together at short ends. Sew to top of quilt center. Sew (1) I $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip to the remainder of strip from the top and sew to bottom of the quilt center. Press and trim even with quilt sides.
14. Repeat step 12 and 13 using (7) C $31 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.

## FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top and baste or pin. When quilting is completed trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
