CUT cut pieces via wof
(2) $5-1 / 4$ " $x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $5-1 / 4$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) 5-1/4" triangles.
(2) $5-1 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $5-1 / 4$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) 5-1/4" triangles.
(7) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, BINDING.
(3) $4-7 / 8$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $4-7 / 8$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (48) $4-7 / 8$ " triangles.
(8) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(16) $1-1 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (62) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(3) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
(5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
(6) 2 " x WOF strips. ${ }^{*}$
(6) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. ${ }^{*}$

* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

## Block Assembly

1. Place (1) G $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on the top left corner of (1) F 4-1/2" square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the sewn seam.

2. Follow the diagram below for the seam direction to add a G 2-1/2" square to each of the remaining corners of the F 4-1/2" square to make (1) Unit 1 square.
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (20) Unit 1 squares total.

4. Sew (1) E $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) D 2-1/2" x $8-1 / 2$ " strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 2 strip. Repeat to make (31) Unit 2 strips total.

5. Sew (1) A 5-1/4" triangle and (1) B 5-1/4" triangle together along short sides. Sew (1) C 4-7/8" triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4-1/2" Unit 3 square. Repeat to make (48) Unit 3 squares total.

6. Sew together (4) Unit 3 squares into a $2 \times 2$ matrix to make (1) 8-1/2" Unit 4 square. Repeat to make (12) Unit 4 squares total.

## Quilt Assembly

7. Sew together (4) Unit 1 squares and (3) Unit 2 strips, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five, Row Seven and Row Nine.
8. Sew together (4) Unit 2 strips and (3) Unit 4 squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four, Row Six and Row Eight.
9. Sew together the (9) Rows from Steps 7-8, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the Center Block.


BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE H AND I BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.
10. Sew (1) H 2 " $\mathrm{x}\left(52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew H (1) 2" x (43-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) I 6-1/2" $x\left(55-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) I 6-1/2" x (55-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
