## CUT cut pieces via wof

Fussy cut (1) $23^{\prime \prime}$ x 42-1/2" rectangle, centered on the panel.
(2) 2 " $\times 42-1 / 2$ " WOF strips, piece as needed.
(2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 26^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
(5) $1-1 / 2$ " $x$ WOF strips. ${ }^{*}$
(7) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. ${ }^{*}$
(8) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, BINDING.
(2) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strips.

From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
(5) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips.*
(7) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.*
(4) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut (14) 4-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips.
(1) $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Subcut (2) $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(1) $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(8) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips.
(1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Subcut (4) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY
WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

## Note: The arrows in figures

 represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.
## Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) B $2^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the A 23 " $\times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew (1) B 2" x 26 " strip to the top and to the bottom of the A rectangle to make the Center Block. Trim the block to measure 24-1/2" x 44-1/2".

Center Block

2. Follow the diagram at right and sew together (4) E 4-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips, (2) F $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (1) F $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.

3. Follow the diagram below and sew together (2) H 4-1/2" squares, (3) E 4-1/2" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (2) F $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

## Quilt Assembly

4. Sew (1) C 6-1/2" x (44-1/2") strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) C 6-1/2" x (36-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
5. Sew (1) B $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times\left(56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" x (38-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
6. Sew (1) D $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}\left(58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) D 1-1/2" x (40-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) D $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}\left(68-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) D 1-1/2" x (50-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) B $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}\left(70-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" x (52-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) G 6-1/2" x (72-1/2") strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) G 6-1/2" x (64-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 64" x 84"
