## BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

1. Find the center of (1) D HST and one side of (1) A 6-7/8" square. Place right sides together, lining up centers, pin, then sew and press. Repeat on opposite side using another D HST, then on remaining sides using E HSTs to complete the BLOCK. Square to $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, being careful to leave $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance beyond the points of the HSTs, make (30).

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper block placement and rotation.

2. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements
3. Sew (1) B $2^{\prime \prime} X\left(54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) B $2^{\prime \prime} X\left(48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.
4. Sew (1) C 3-1/2" $X\left(57-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) B 3-1/2" $X\left(54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.

## FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing $3^{\prime \prime}$ larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with $\mathbf{E}$ fabric.
