(3) 3-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut (30) 3-7/8" squares.
(4) $4-1 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Subcut (30) 4-1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (120) 4-1/4" triangles.
(6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (120) 2" squares.
(7) 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (60) 4-1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (240) 4-1/4" triangles.
(6) 3-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut (60) 3-7/8" squares.
(8) 2 " x WOF strips.*

CUT CUT PIECES VIA WOF
(3) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut (15) 6-1/2" squares.
(8) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips.*

1. Place (1) D 3-7/8" square on top of (1) F 3-7/8" square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3-1/2" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares. Repeat to make (60) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to the figure at right for fabric identification and placement to make (60) Unit 2 squares.

3. Sew (1) E 4-1/4" triangle and (1) F 4-1/4" triangle together along short sides. Sew (1) C 3-7/8" triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 3-1/2" Unit 3 square. Repeat to make (60) Unit 3 squares total.

Unit 3

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to the diagrams below for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (60) of each unit square for Unit 4 through Unit 6.

5. Place (1) B 2" square on the bottom right corner of (1) Unit 3 square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the sewn seam to make (1) Unit 7 square. Repeat to make (60) Unit 7 squares total.

Unit 7

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to the diagrams for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (60) Unit 8 squares, (60) Unit 9 squares and (60) Unit 10 squares.

7. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to the left side of (1) Unit 8 square to make (1) Unit 11 rectangle. Repeat to make (60) Unit 11 rectangles total.

8. Sew (1) Unit 9 square to the left side of (1) Unit 10 square to make (1) Unit 12 rectangle. Repeat to make (60) Unit 12 rectangles total.

Unit 12

9. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of (1) Unit 11 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 11 strip to each side of (1) A $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12-1/2" Block One square. Repeat to make (15) Block One squares total.

Block One

10. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each end of (1) Unit 12 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 12 strip to each side of (1) $\mathbf{G}$ $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12-1/2" Block Two square. Repeat to make (15) Block Two squares total.


## Quilt Assembly

11. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three and Row Five.
12. Sew together (3) Block Two squares and (2) Block One squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four and Row Six.
13. Sew together the (6) Rows from Steps 11-12, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to bottom, to make the 60-1/2" x 72-1/2" Center Block.


BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE F, C AND A BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.
14. Sew (1) F 2 " $\times 72-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) F 2" x 63-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) C 2 " $\times 75-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) C 2 " x 66-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Sew (1) A 6-1/2" $\times 78-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) A 6-1/2" x 78-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 78" x 90"
