

BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS.
TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X
5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5"
LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT.
IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST
YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.


Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) B 2" x 6-1/4" strip to each side of (1) A 6-1/4" square. Sew (1) B 2" x 9-1/4" strip to the top and to the bottom of the A square to make (1) Unit 1 square. Trim the block to measure 8" x 8". Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.




- 2. Sew (1) C 1-3/4" x 8" strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) C 1-3/4" x 10-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square. Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 squares total.
- 3. Sew (1) D 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) D 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) 12-1/2" Block One square. Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.



4. Place (1) **D** 3-7/8" square on top of (1) **H** 3-7/8" square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3-1/2" square to make (2) **Unit 3** squares. Repeat to make (24) **Unit 3** squares total.




5. Place (1) **F** 3-1/2" square on the left side of (1) **G** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.






- **6.** Place another **F** 3-1/2" square on the right side of the **G** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) **Unit 4** strip.
- 7. Repeat **Steps 5-6** to make (24) **Unit 4** strips total.






8. Sew (1) **Unit 3** square to each end of (1) **Unit 4** strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) **Unit 4** strip to each side of (1) E 6-1/2" square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12-1/2" **Block Two** square. Repeat to make (6) **Block Two** squares total.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

- **9.** Sew (1) **Block One** square to each side of (1) **Block Two** square to make **Row One**. Repeat to make **Row Three**.
- **10.** Sew (1) **Block Two** square to each side of (1) **Block One** square to make **Row Two**. Repeat to make **Row Four**.
- 11. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 9-10, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 36-1/2" x 48-1/2" Center Block.



BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE I AND J BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.


12. Sew (1) I 2" x (48-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) I 2" x (39-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

13. Sew (1) J 6-1/2" x (51-1/2") LOF strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) J 6-1/2" x (51-1/2") WOF strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
