

Yardage & Cutting:

Number in parenthesis is the quantity to cut

Etched Tulips Panel - Black - 13131-12 1 panel
Cut (1) 20-1/2" square of Wreath

Dotted Damask - Lt Pink - 2569-01 1/4 yd
Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips into:
(2) 1-1/2" x 22-1/2"
(2) 1-1/2" x 20-1/2"

Marguerite Scroll - Med Green - 10425-41 3/8 yd
Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips into:
(24) 2-7/8" squares
Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips into:
(2) 1-1/2" x 24-1/2"
(2) 1-1/2" x 22-1/2"

Wave Texture - Black - 2966-12 1 yd
Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips into:
(28) 3-1/2" x 2-1/2"
Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips into:
(24) 2-7/8" squares
Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips into:
(32) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips for Binding

Yardage & Cutting- Cont

Marguerite Scroll - Med Pink - 10425-21 5/8 yd
Cut (4) 4-1/2" strips into:
(56) 4-1/2" x 2-1/2"

Pearl Fern - Dk Green - 10427-42 5/8 yd
Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips into:
(28) 3-1/2" x 2-1/2"
Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips into:
(28) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips into:
(2) 1-1/2" x 40-1/2"
(2) 1-1/2" x 38-1/2"

Etched Tulip Toss - Black - 13134-12 1/4 yd
Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip into"
(4) 5-1/2" squares

Etched Tulips Stripe - Black - 13133-12 1-5/8 yds
Cut (4) VERTICAL stripes, centering Tulips

Backing 3-1/2 yds

Construction:

This project uses precise 1/4" seams. To test your seam allowance, accurately cut (2) 1-1/2" x 3" rectangles. Stitch them together along the 3" length. Measure across the unit. It should be exactly 2-1/2" wide. If not, adjust your seam and repeat.

1. Stitch a 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" Lt Pink Dotted Damask to the right and left sides of the 20-1/2" Wreath square. Send the seams toward the Pink. Then attach the 1-1/2" x 22-1/2" Lt Pink Dotted Damask to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the Pink.

2. As in Step 1, attach the 1-1/2" x 22-1/2" Med Green Marguerite Scroll to the sides and the 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" of same to the top and bottom on the Wreath. Press toward the Green.




3. Place a 2-7/8" square of Med Green Marguerite Scroll right sides together with a 2-7/8" square of Black Wave Texture. On the back of the green side, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Accurately stitch 1/4" to each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line. Press half of the seams to the Black and half to the Green sides. They measure 2-1/2" square from raw edge to raw edge. Make 24, which will yield 48 of these Triangle Squares.



4. Consistently using 2 Triangle Squares that are pressed oppositely, stitch them together in pairs as shown. Take care to always have the same pressed option in the same position on all of these pairs. Do not press their joining seam yet. They should measure 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" from raw edge to raw edge. Make 24.



5. Join the Step 4 units in four strings, each 6 units long. Gently direct the seams in the direction indicated by the arrow. They are all alike, and should measure 24-1/2" in length.



6. Stitch the Green side of two of the Step 5 units to opposite sides of Step 2.




7. Add a 2-1/2" square of Black Wave Texture to both ends of the remaining two Step 5 units. Sew these to the top and bottom of the Step 6 unit.

8. Right sides together, diagonally stitch a 2-1/2" square of Black Wave Texture onto the right corner of a 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" Med Pink Marguerite Scroll. Trim the excess from the corner and direct the seam toward the Black. Make 28.



9. Right sides together, diagonally stitch a 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" of Dk Green Pearl Fern onto the left corner of Step 8. Trim the excess from the corner and direct the seam toward the Green. Make 28. They measure 5-1/2" x 2-1/2" from raw edge to raw edge.




10. Repeat Steps 8 & 9 EXCEPT use a 2-1/2" square of Dk Green Pearl Fern on the left. Trim and direct the seam toward the Green, then add a 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" Black Wave Texture on the right. Trim and direct the seam toward the Black. Make 28. They are also 5-1/2" x 2-1/2" from raw edge to raw edge.



11. Place a Step 10 unit on top of a Step 9., Sew these units together. They measure 5-1/2" x 4-1/2" tall from raw edge to raw edge. Make 28.



12. Stitch 7 of the Step 11 units together. Direct the seams as the arrow indicates. These measure 5-1/2" x 28-1/2" from raw edge to raw edge. Make 4.



13. Placing the Black edge of Step 12 next to the two sides of the Step 7 unit, sew them in place. Seams should be alternating, and they should be the same length.

14. Add a 5-1/2" square of Black Etched Tulip Toss to both ends of the remaining two Step 12 units. Stitch these to the top and bottom. Press gently. Your quilt now measures 38-1/2" square from raw edge to raw edge.



15. Attach the 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips of Dk Green Pearl Fern to both sides of your quilt, followed by the 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips of the same to the top and bottom. Press gently.

16. Attach the Etched Tulips Stripe borders. Begin and end at the 1/4" seam allowance at each corner, and leave a 8" miter 'tail' extending.

17. Place a corner to miter on your ironing board, with the border that is lying horizontal extending to the right, and the one that is vertical on top of it and extending up. Fold the top extending border diagonally under and position so it is exactly on top of the one extending to the right. Once you are satisfied that the miter is correct, smash it with the iron.



18. Use a pin or two to hold the mitered corner in place. From the underside, stitch in the pressed crease. Check to see that it's correct and if it is, trim the excess from the seam to 1/4". Press these seams open. Repeat Steps 17-18 for each of the corners to be mitered.



19. Layer your quilt and prepare to quilt your masterpiece. We suggest outlining the Tulips in the wreath and in the Border,, and add a simple floral to the rest of the quilt.

20. Bind with the 2-1/2 strips of Black Wave Texture, following the instructions with the Binding Miter Tool. There is also a video demo of this terrific tool at [YouTube.com](https://www.youtube.com)
