

A	Morning Glories 3012-72 Ivory/Peach	1/2 yd	(1) 15-1/2" x 21-1/2" rectangle.
В	Swirling Vines 3023-26 Peach/Blush	1/2 yd	(1) 6-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 6-7-8" squares. (2) 2" x 21-1/2" WOF strips. (1) 2" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 2" x 18-1/2" strips.
C	Swirl Fan 1036-26 <i>Mauve/Lilac</i>	2 yds	(9) 7-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (43) 7-1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (172) 7-1/4" triangles.
D	Swirling Vines 3023-44 <i>Olive</i>	1-2/3 yds	(5) 7-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (22) 7-1/4" triangles. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (88) 7-1/4" triangles. Note: You will only use (86) triangles.  (8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, BINDING.
E	Garden Damask 3021-77 <i>Ivory</i>	1-1/3 yds	(5) 7-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (22) 7-1/4" triangles. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (88) 7-1/4" triangles. Note: You will only use (86) triangles.  (1) 6-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 6-7-8" squares.
F	Key Stripe 3020-42 <i>Olive/Aubergir</i>	1-1/8 yds ie	(4) 3-1/2" x 36 ½" WOF strips. (8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.*
G	Plumes 3022-72 <i>Ivory/Blush</i>	1-5/8 yds	(7) 7-1/2" x WOF strips.*

<sup>\*</sup> SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

Note: Pay attention to the orientation of the units when assembling the various components.


1. Sew (1) B 2" x 21-1/2" strip to each side of the A 15-1/2" x 21-1/2" rectangle. Sew (1) B 2" x 18-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the A rectangle to make the 18-1/2" x 24-1/2" Center Block.




**2.** Place (1) **B** 6-7/8" square on top of (1) **E** 6-7/8" square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 6-1/2" square to make (2) **Unit 1** squares. Repeat to make (12) **Unit 1** squares total.









3. Sew (1) C 7-1/4" triangle and (1) E 7-1/4" triangle together along short sides to make (1) CE triangle. Sew (1) D 7-1/4" triangle and (1) C 7-1/4" triangle together along short sides to make (1) DC triangle. Sew the CE triangle and DC triangle together along their long sides to make (1) 6-1/2" Unit 2 square. Repeat to make (86) Unit 2 squares total.




**4.** Sew (4) **Unit 2** squares together to make (1) **Inner Side Border**. Repeat to make a second **Inner Side Border**.



**5.** Sew (3) **Unit 2** squares together. Sew (1) **Unit 1** square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the **Inner Top Border**. Repeat to make the **Inner Bottom Border**.



**6.** Sew (7) **Unit 2** squares together to make (1) **Middle Side Border**. Repeat to make a second **Middle Side Border**.




**7.** Sew (6) **Unit 2** squares together. Sew (1) **Unit 1** square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the **Middle Top Border**. Repeat to make the **Middle Bottom Border**.

Middle Top/Bottom Border make 2



**8.** Sew (12) **Unit 2** squares together to make (1) **Outer Side Border**. Repeat to make a second **Outer Side Border**.



**9.** Sew (11) **Unit 2** squares together. Sew (1) **Unit 1** square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the **Outer Top Border**. Repeat to make the **Outer Bottom Border**.

## **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

**10.** Sew (1) **Inner Side Border** to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew the **Inner Top Border** and **Inner Bottom Border** to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE F, G AND F BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.


- **11.** Sew (1) **F** 3-1/2" x (36-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **F** 3-1/2" x (36-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.
- **12.** Sew (1) **Middle Side Border** to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew the **Middle Top Border** and **Middle Bottom Border** to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

- **13.** Sew (1) **G** 7-1/2" x (54-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **G** 7-1/2" x (62-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.
- **14.** Sew (1)  $\mathbf{F}$  2-1/2"  $\mathbf{x}$  (68-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1)  $\mathbf{F}$  2-1/2"  $\mathbf{x}$  (66-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.
- **15.** Sew (1) Outer Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

**FINISHING** Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
