CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS WOF = Width of fabric | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern **FLOWER DOT** (2) 5" X WOF strips, 3/8 YD **E** 13211-04 subcut (10) 5" squares **PLAYHOUSE PALS** Lt. Turquoise 1 Fussy Cut to: A PANEL Panel 22-1/2" X 42-1/2" **FLOWER DOT** 13202-99 Multi (2) 5" X WOF strips, 3/8 YD **F** 13211-08 subcut (8) 5" squares Lt. Gray **SUNNYSIDE FLOWER DOT** (2) 5" X WOF strips, (5) 3-1/2" X WOF strips*, **B** 13205-84 5/8 YD **G** 13211-09 3/8 YD **BORDER** subcut (10) 5" squares White **Turquoise** (4) 2-1/2" X WOF strips*, **FLOWER DOT** WOODSY (2) 5" X WOF strips, 3/8 YD BORDER 3/8 YD C 13212-13 **H** 13211-40 subcut (10) 5" squares Cloud Lime **FLOWER DOT LEAFY**

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: *Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS*

D 13211-03

Lt. Yellow

Draw diagonal line on wrong side of F 5" square. Place right sides together with D 5" square and sew 1/4" on either side of diagonal line, then cut on drawn line. Press open and square to 4-1/2" to complete FD BLOCK, make (8).

3/8 YD

As in Step 1 create DE BLOCKS (9), EG BLOCKS (9), GH BLOCKS (10), HF BLOCKS (8) and DH BLOCKS (1), drawing diagonal line on wrong side of lighter fabrics in the pair. Note: you will have (1) extra DE and DH BLOCK to save for another project.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements

- 3. Sew (1) **C** 2-1/2" X (42-1/2") strip to sides of **A** 22-1/2" X 42-1/2" rectangle, then sew (1) **C** 2-1/2" X (26-1/2") strip to top and bottom.
- 4. Sew (1) **B** 3-1/2" X (46-1/2") strip to each side, then sew (1) **B** 3-1/2" X (32-1/2") strip to top and bottom.



5. For pieced border sew blocks together into **BORDER UNITS**, then sew to quilt. Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

LEFT BORDER UNIT: HF - GH - EG - DE - FD - HF - GH - EG - DE - FD - HF - GH - EG
RIGHT BORDER UNIT: GH - EG - DE - FD - HF - GH - EG - DE - FD - HF - GH - EG - DE
TOP BORDER UNIT: FD - DE - EG - GH - HF - FD - DE - EG - GH - DH
BOTTOM BORDER UNIT: DE - EG - GH - HF - FD - DE - EG - GH - HF - FD

(2) 5" X WOF strips,

subcut (10) 5" squares

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with J fabric.
