CUT cut pieces via wof

Fussy cut (1) 22-1/2" x $42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ panel.
(2) 4 " x 42-1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
(2) $2^{\prime \prime}$ x 29-1/2" WOF strips.
(3) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips.*
(2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
(12) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (320) 1-1/2" squares.
(3) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub cut (40) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
(3) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Subcut (40) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
(3) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-
cut (40) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
(3) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Subcut (40) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
(2) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strips.
From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 48-1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
(6) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips, BINDING.

1. Sew (1) B 4 " $\times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the $\mathbf{A} 22-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew (1) B 2 " x 29-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the A rectangle to make the Center Block. Trim the block to measure 28-1/2" x 44-1/2".
BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

2. Place (1) C $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on the bottom left corner of (1) D 2-1/2" square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.
3. Follow the diagram below for the seam direction to add a C 1-1/2" square to the upper right corner of the $\mathbf{D}$ $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to make (1) Unit 1 square.
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (40) Unit 1 squares total.

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to the diagrams to make (40) Unit 2 squares, (16) Unit 3 squares, (40) Unit 4 squares and (24) Unit 5 squares.


Unit 5

6. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square to the make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to the left side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 4-1/2" Block One square. Repeat to make (20) Block One squares total.

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to the diagrams below to make (8) Block Two squares and (12) Block Three squares.

8. Sew together (6) Block Three squares and (5) Block One squares, alternating them from the top to the bottom, to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.

Side Border

9. Sew together (5) Block One squares and (4) Block Two squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.


Quilt Assembly
10. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
11. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE E, C AND I BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.
12. Sew (1) B $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times\left(52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) B 2-1/2" x ( $40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) H 4-1/2" $x$ (56-1/2") strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) H 4-1/2" x (48-1/2") to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 48" x 64"
