


CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric | HST = Half Square Triangle | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern




BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAMS**

 Following the BLOCK IMAGES below, sew the G and N HSTs to the sides of C, D, E, F, H, J, K, L, and M squares to create blocks. Square all to 5-1/2"(trimming 1/4" past the points), make number indicated.




BLOCK DIAGRAMS





Sew HSTs to opposite sides first, then sew HSTs to remaining sides.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements

- 2. BORDER 1: Sew (1) P 1-1/2" X (42-1/2") strip to each side of A 23-1/2" X 42-1/2" rectangle, then sew (1) P 2" X (25-1/2") strip to top and bottom.
- 3. BORDER 2: Sew blocks together into **BORDER UNITS**, then sew to quilt. Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

LEFT BORDER UNIT: H1 - F4 - J1 - D4 - K1 - E4 - L1 - C4 - M1 RIGHT BORDER UNIT: M1 - C2 - L1 - E2 - K1 - D2 - J1 - F2 - H1

TOP BORDER UNIT: D1 - L1 - F1 - K1 - C1 - J1 - E1

BOTTOM BORDER UNIT: E3 - H1 - C3 - J1 - F3 - M1 - D3

- 4. BORDER 3: Sew (1) P 1-1/2" X (55-1/2") strip to sides of quilt, then sew (1) P 1-1/2" X (37-1/2") strip to top and bottom.
- 5. BORDER 4: Sew (1) N 1-1/2" X (57-1/2") strip to sides of quilt, then sew (1) N 1-1/2" X (39-1/2") strip to top and bottom.
- 6. BORDER 5: Sew (1) **B** 4-1/2" X (59-1/2") strip to sides of quilt, then sew (1) **B** 4-1/2" X (47-1/2") strip to top and bottom.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **P** fabric.
