WOF = Width of fabric / *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

1. Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of (72) B 2" squares.
2. Place (1) B square on one end of (1) F $2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip.

Sew on drawn line, trim 1/4" from sewn line, then press.
3. Repeat step 2 on other end of $\mathbf{F}$ strip (noting rotation of $\boldsymbol{B}$ square) to compete BF UNIT. Square to $2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, make (36).
4. Sew (1) D 2" square to each end of (1) BF UNIT to create DBF UNIT. Square to $2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{X}$ 13-1/2", make (18).
5. Sew (1) B $2^{\prime \prime}$ square to each end of (1) $\mathbf{E} \mathbf{2 "}^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to create BE UNIT. Square to $2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, make (18).
6. Sew (1) E 2" X 7-1/2" strip to each side of (1) C 7-1/2" square, then sew (1) BE UNIT to top and bottom.
7. Sew (1) BF UNIT to each side, then sew (1) DBF UNIT to top and bottom to complete BLOCK 1. Square to 13-1/2", make (5).

## BLOCK DIAGRAMS



QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper block placement and rotation.
9. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

ROWS 1 and 3: BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1
ROW 2: BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements
10. Sew (1) B $2^{\prime \prime} X\left(39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) B $2^{\prime \prime} X\left(42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.
11. Measure top and bottom of quilt, cut (2) F $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to fit ( $42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) and set aside. Sew (1) F 3-1/2" $X$ ( $42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip to each side of quilt. Sew (1) E 3-1/2" square to each end of set aside $F$ strips, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING:
Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with B fabric.
