

WOF = Width of fabric | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern






BLOCK ASSEMBLY: *Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS*

- 1. Sew (1) **N1** strip to each side of (1) **A** 6-1/2" square, then sew (1) **N2** strip to top and bottom.
- 2. Sew (1) **S2** strip to each side, then sew (1) **S1** strip to top and bottom to create **BLOCK 1**. Square to 12-1/2", make (15).
- 3. Sew (2) N3 strips and (1) S1 strip together to create MIDDLE UNIT. Square to 3-1/2" X 12-1/2", make (15).
- 4. Sew (2) **N4** strips, (1) **Q** square, (1) **N5** strip and (1) **L** square as shown, then sew (1) **N3** strip to top to create **UPPER UNIT**.
- Sew (2) N4 strips, (1) F square, (1) N5 strip and (1) Q square as shown, then sew (1) N3 strip to bottom to create LOWER UNIT.
- 6. Sew **UNITS** together to create **BLOCK 2A**. Square to 12-1/2", make (3).
- 7. Repeat steps 3 6 using pieces indicated below to create **BLOCKS 2B, 2C** and **2D**. Square all to 12-1/2", make (4) each.





QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper block placement and rotation.

8. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

ROWS 1 and 5: BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2A - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2B - BLOCK 1

ROW 2: BLOCK 2C - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2D - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2C

ROW 3: BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2B - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2A - BLOCK 1

ROW 4: BLOCK 2D - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2C - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2D

ROW 6: BLOCK 2B - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2D - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2C

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements

9. Sew (1) \mathbf{T} 1-1/2" \mathbf{X} (72-1/2") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) \mathbf{T} 2-1/2" \mathbf{X} (62-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt.



FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **Q** fabric.
