




## **BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS**


- Sew (1) F2 strip to each side of (1) A 6-1/2" square, then sew (1) F1 strip to top and bottom to create BLOCK 1A.
   Square to 9-1/2", make (6).
- Repeat step 2 using fabrics indicated to create BLOCK 1B,
   1C and BLOCK 1D as shown on next page. Square all to
   9-1/2", make (4) each.
- 3. Sew (1) M 1-1/2" X 9-1/2" strip to each side of (1) L 4-1/2" X 9-1/2" strip, then sew (1) E2 2" X 9-1/2" strip to sides to create BLOCK 2A. Square to 9-1/2", make (9).
- Sew (1) M 1-1/2" X 9-1/2" strip to top and bottom of (1) L 4-1/2" X 9-1/2" strip, then sew (1) E1 9-1/2" X 2" strip to top and bottom to create BLOCK 2B. Square to 9-1/2", make (8).


## **BLOCK DIAGRAMS**

















**QUILT ASSEMBLY:** Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper block placement and rotation.

5. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

ROWS 1 & 7: 1B-2B-1D-2B-1C

ROWS 2, 4 & 6: 2A—1A—2A—1A—2A

ROW 3: 1C-2B-1B-2B-1D ROW 5: 1D-2B-1C-2B-1B

**BORDER ASSEMBLY:** Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements

6. Sew (1) M 1-1/2"  $\times$  (63-1/2") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) M 1-1/2"  $\times$  (47-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt.

7. Sew (1) K 3-1/2" X (65-1/2") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) K 3-1/2" X (53-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt.

### **FINISHING**:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **E** fabric.
