## BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

## BLOCK DIAGRAMS

1. Sew (1) C 1-1/2" $X$ 10-1/2" strip to each side of (1) A 10-1/2" square, then sew (1) C 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" strip to top and bottom to create BLOCK 1. Square to $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, make (5).
2. Sew (1) F 2-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top and bottom of (1) B 8-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to create BLOCK 2A. Square to 12-1/2", make (2).
3. As in step 2 , sew (2) F 2-1/2" $\times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (1) B 8-1/2" $\times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip together to create BLOCK 2B. Square to 12-1/2" X 36-1/2", make (2).
4. Subcut the following from $\mathbf{D}, \mathbf{E}$, and $\mathbf{G}$ long strips:

D: (2) 4-1/2" $\times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and
(2) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips


BLOCK 1 make (5)日a

E \& G: (4) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (4) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
5. Sew (1) E 2-1/2" $\times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top and bottom of (1) D 4-1/2" $\times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, then sew (1) G 2-1/2" $\times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top and bottom to create BLOCK 3A. Square to $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, make (2).
6. As in step 5 , sew the $\mathbf{D} 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip together with $\mathbf{E}$ and $\mathbf{G} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X$ $48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to create BLOCK 3B. Square to $12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, make (2).


QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper block placement and rotation.
7. Cut (4) H 2-1/2" $X$ 60-1/2" sashing strips.
8. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows and sashing strips together.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.
9. Sew (1) H 2-1/2" $X\left(68-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) H 2-1/2" $X\left(64-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.
