## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric | LOF = Length of fabric | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

## BLOCK DIAGRAMS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of $\mathbf{F} 3-1 / 4$ " squares.
2. Place (1) $\mathbf{F} 3-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square right sides together on one side of (1) D 3-1/4" X $6^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line, then cut $1 / 4$ " from drawn line and press. Repeat on other side to create DF UNIT. Square to 3-1/4" X 6" , make (14).
3. Repeat step 2 using $\mathbf{F} 3-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares and $\mathbf{E} 3-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ " rectangles to create EF UNITS. Square to $3-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$, make (14).
4. Sew (4) DF UNITS and (4) EF UNITS together, then sew (1) F $3-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 22-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side to create BLOCK 1. Square to $11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, make (2).
5. As in step 5, Sew (3) DF UNITS, (3) EF UNITS and (2) F 3-1/4" X $17^{\prime \prime}$ strips together to create BLOCK 2. Square to $11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 17^{\prime \prime}$, make (2).

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.
6. Sew BLOCKS and A SQUARES together into vertical rows, rows, then sew pieced rows and C LOF STRIPS together.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.
7. From pieced $\mathbf{F}$ strip, subcut (4) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X 6^{\prime \prime}$ strips and set aside. Use remainder of pieced F strip for Steps 8 and 9.
8. Sew (1) F 1-1/2" $X\left(44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) B LOF $6^{\prime \prime} \times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side.
9. Sew (1) F 1-1/2" $X\left(57-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.
10. Sew (2) C $6^{\prime \prime}$ squares, (2) F 1-1/2" X $6^{\prime \prime}$ strips from Step 7 and (1) B LOF $6^{\prime \prime} \times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip together, then sew to top of quilt. Repeat for bottom of quilt.

## FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with $\mathbf{F}$ fabric.
