

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: *Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS*

- 1. Stitch a **D** triangle and an **E** triangle on long side to make a **BLOCK 1**. Square to 8-1/2", make (4).
- 2. Stitch an **A** triangle and a **C** triangle on long side to make a **UNIT 1**. Make (32).
- 3. Join (2) UNIT 1 to make a UNIT 2. Make (16).
- 4. Sew together the following to create units and make number indicated.

UNIT 3: **UNIT 2** and (2) **F** squares, 2-1/2" x 8-1/2", make (8).

UNIT 4: **G** square and (2) **UNIT 2,** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2", make (4).

5. Sew (2) **UNIT 3** and (1) **UNIT 4** together as shown to create **BLOCK 2.** Square to 8-1/2", make (4).





QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

1. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

ROWS 1 and 3: BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1 ROW 2: BLOCK 2 - D Square - BLOCK 2

2. Join rows to complete the quilt center.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.


Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

- 3. Sew (2) **G** 1-1/2" x (24-1/2") strips to each side of quilt and (2) **G** 1-1/2" x (26-1/2") strips to top and bottom.
- 4. Sew (2) **B** 4-1/2" x (26-1/2") strips to each side of quilt.
- 5. Join (2) **G** squares to opposite ends of remaining B strips to make BORDER STRIPS. Make (2).
- 6. Sew BORDER STRIPS to top and bottom to complete quilt top.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **G** fabric.
