## BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

1. Stitch a $\mathbf{D}$ triangle and an $\mathbf{E}$ triangle on long side to make a

BLOCK 1. Square to 8-1/2", make (4).
2. Stitch an A triangle and a C triangle on long side to make a UNIT 1. Make (32).
3. Join (2) UNIT 1 to make a UNIT 2. Make (16).
4. Sew together the following to create units and make number indicated.

UNIT 3: UNIT 2 and (2) F squares, $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, make (8).
UNIT 4: G square and (2) UNIT 2, 2-1/2" x 8-1/2", make (4).
5. Sew (2) UNIT 3 and (1) UNIT 4 together as shown to create BLOCK 2. Square to 8-1/2", make (4).

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

1. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

ROWS 1 and 3: BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1
ROW 2: BLOCK 2 - D Square - BLOCK 2
2. Join rows to complete the quilt center.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements. Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.
3. Sew (2) G $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times\left(24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips to each side of quilt and (2) G 1-1/2" $\times\left(26-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips to top and bottom.
4. Sew (2) B $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times\left(26-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips to each side of quilt.
5. Join (2) $\mathbf{G}$ squares to opposite ends of remaining $B$ strips to make BORDER STRIPS. Make (2).
6. Sew BORDER STRIPS to top and bottom to complete quilt top.

## FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing $3^{\prime \prime}$ larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with $\mathbf{G}$ fabric.
