

Yardage & Cutting:

Number in parenthesis is the quantity to cut

Black Botanical Season -13460M-12 1-1/2 yds Cut (4) 12-1/2" strips into:

3/4 yd

2-5/8 yds

(12) 12-1/2" squares

Red Seasonal Scroll -13466-10

Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips into:

(20) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (8) 2" strips into:

(160) 2" squares

Green Seasonal Scroll - 13466-44

Cut (17) 3-1/2" strips into:

(45) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2"

(22) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips for Binding

Cut (4) 2" strips into:

(80) 2" squares

Backing 3-5/8 yds

Binding Miter Tool

Construction:

This project uses precise 1/4" seams. To test your seam allowance, accurately cut (2) 1-1/2" x 3" rectangles. Stitch them together along the 3" length. Measure across the unit. It should be exactly 2-1/2" wide. If not, adjust your seam and repeat.

1. Place a 2" square of Green right sides facing on top of a corner of a 3-1/2" square of Red. Stitch diagonally across, corner to corner. Trim the excess Green only from the corner. Fold the Green back to the corner and finger press. Make 20.



2. Repeat Step 1 on the the remaining corners of the Step 1 units. After each corner, trim and finger press in place.



3. In the same manner, diagonally stitch two 2" squares of Red to each end of 31 of the 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" Green rectangles. At each end be sure to trim and finger press after the first one before adding the second. Make 31. Note: there will be 14 of these rectangles remaining plain.



4. In the same manner, diagonally stitch two 2" squares of Red to one side of 18 of the 3-1/2" squares of Green. Trim and press as before. Make 18. There are 4 plain squares remaining.



- 5. Layout the quilt following the diagram. Sew it together. Press gently.
- 6. Layer your quilt and prepare to quilt your masterpiece. We suggest outlining the stars in the sashing and in the Border, add a simple swirl to the remaining background, and outline some of the ornaments.
- NOTE: If this Animas Quilts & Benartex pattern is included in a kit, any questions about the kit should be addressed to the vendor from whom you bought it.
- 7. Bind with the 2-1/2 strips specified, following the instructions with the Binding Miter Tool. There is also a video demo of this terrific tool at YouTube.com
