## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric | LOF = Length of fabric | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

Note: Blocks use some directional fabrics. Note orientation of fabric squares as you assemble units.

1. Sew (1) D 3-1/2" square to the left side of (1) B 3-1/2" square. Sew (1) D 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the top to make UNIT 1A. Square to 6-1/2", make 7 .
2. Sew (1) B 3-1/2" square to the left side of (1) D 3-1/2" square.

Sew (1) D 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the bottom to make UNIT 1B. Square to 6-1/2", make 7
3. In the same way, use $\mathbf{F}$ and $\mathbf{H} 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and $\mathbf{F} 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to make (7) each of UNIT 1C and 1D.
4. Noting orientation, Lay out (1) each UNIT 1A, 1B, 1C and 1D into (2) rows of (2). Sew into rows and join the rows to make BLOCK 1. Square to 12-1/2", make (7).
5. Repeat steps 1-4 to make a total of (6) BLOCK 2 and (7) BLOCK 3 using the fabrics shown.


QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.
6. Sew blocks together into rows; then sew rows together.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.
Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.
7. Sew (1) A 4-1/2" X (60-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt. Sew (1) A 4-1/2" X (56-1/2") strip to top and bottom.

## FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing $3^{\prime \prime}$ larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with $\mathbf{H}$ fabric.
