







 Sew (2) A 3-1/2" squares together, then add (1) C 3-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to complete the BLOCK. Square to 6-1/2", make (72).

## **QUILT ASSEMBLY:** *Refer to* **QUILT DIAGRAM** *for proper block placement and rotation.*

2. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.








BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements

- 3. Sew (1) C 2" X (54-1/2") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) C 2" X (51-1/2") strip to top and bottom of quilt.
- 4. Sew together (19) A 3-1/2" squares to create BORDER UNIT. Make (4). First sew (2) to sides of quilt, then sew (2) to top and bottom of quilt.

## FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **B** fabric.
