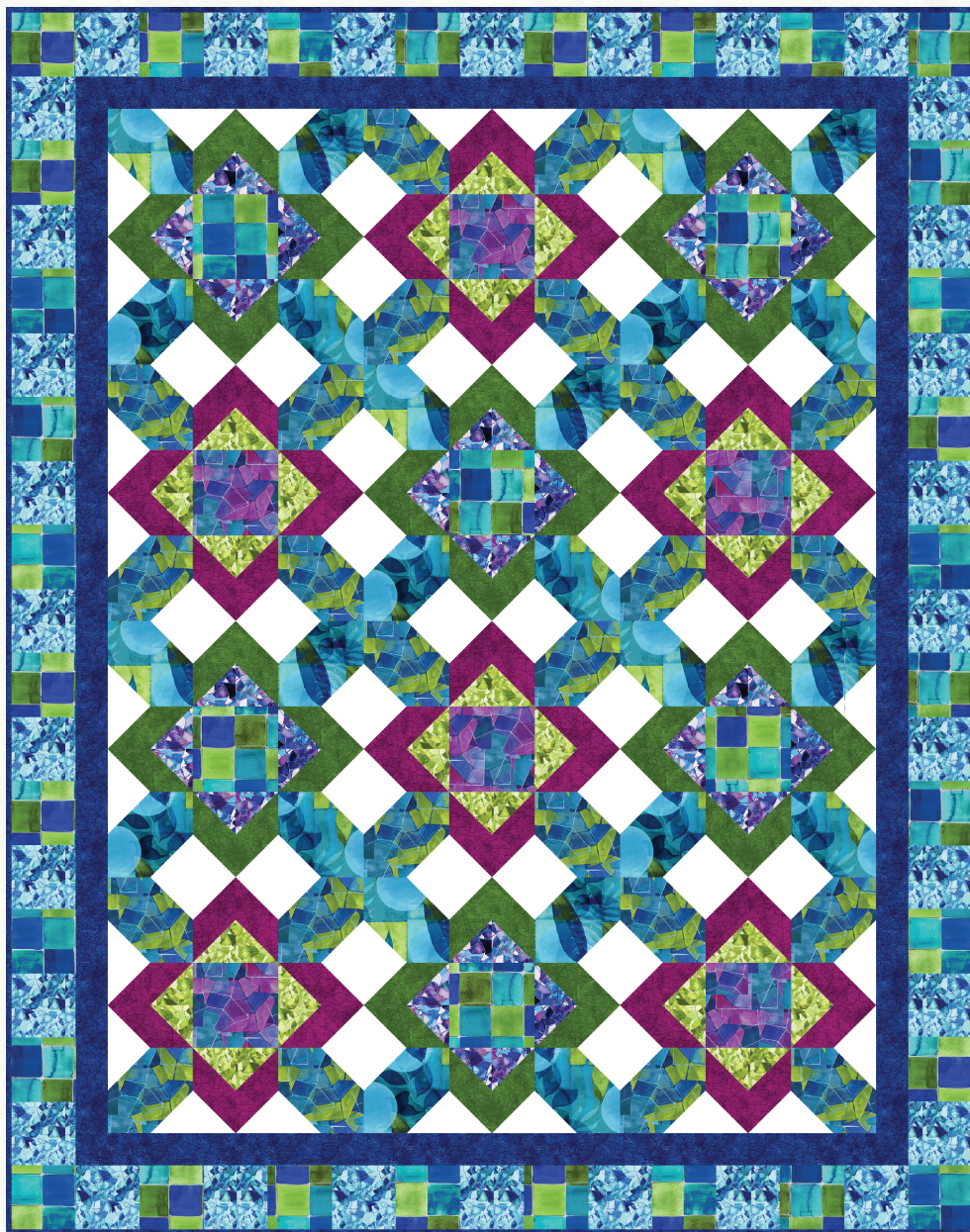

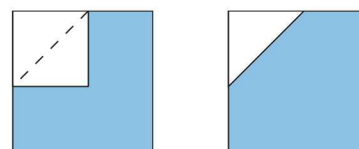

	A Watercolor Squares 16089-84 Turquoise/Multi	5/8 yd	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4-1/2" squares. (3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 3-1/2" squares.	
	B Prismatic Glass 16088-54 Indigo/Multi	1/3 yd	(3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2-1/2" squares.	
	C Glassine Texture 16092-43 Green	1/2 yd	(6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips.	
	D Prismatic Leaves 16086-84 Turquoise/Multi	1/2 yd	(3) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4-1/2" squares.	
	E Geo Prism 16087-64 Purple/Multi	1/4 yd	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4-1/2" squares.	
	F Crushed Glass 16091-44 Lime	1/3 yd	(3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2-1/2" squares.	
	G Glassine Texture 16092-23 Fuchsia	1/2 yd	(6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips.	
	H Geo Prism 16087-84 Turquoise/Multi	1/2 yd	(3) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4-1/2" squares.	
	I Glassine Texture 16092-53 Blue	7/8 yd	(3) 2" x WOF strips.* (2) 2" x 39-1/2" WOF strips. (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, BINDING.	
	J Crushed Glass 16091-82 Turquoise	3/8 yd	(3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 3-1/2" squares.	
	K Superior Solids 3000B09 White	1 yd	(12) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (192) 2-1/2" squares.	

* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY
WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY *PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.*

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

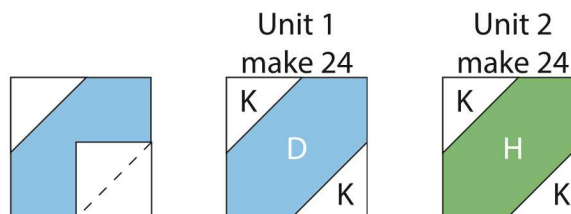
1. Place (1) **K** 2-1/2" square on the top left corner of (1) **D** 4-1/2" square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.



2. Follow the diagram below for the seam direction to add a **K** 2-1/2" square to the bottom right corner of the **D** 4-1/2" square to make (1) **Unit 1** square.

3. Repeat **Steps 1-2** to make (24) **Unit 1** squares total.

4. Repeat **Steps 1-2** and refer to the diagram for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (24) **Unit 2** squares.

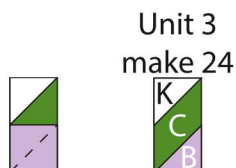


5. Place (1) **K** 2-1/2" square on the top half of (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strip, right sides together and aligning the tops of the fabrics. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

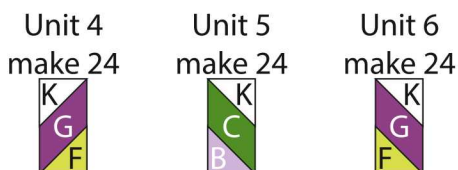


6. Place (1) **B** 2-1/2" square on the bottom half of the **C** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strip, right sides together and aligning the bottoms of the fabrics. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) **Unit 3** strip.

7. Repeat **Steps 5-6** to make (24) **Unit 3** strips total.



8. Repeat **Steps 5-6** and refer to the diagrams for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (24) of each unit strip for **Unit 4** through **Unit 6**.



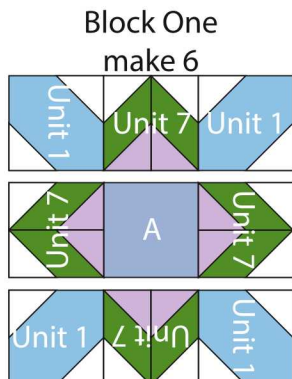
9. Sew (1) **Unit 3** strip to the left side of (1) **Unit 5** strip lengthwise to make (1) 4-1/2" **Unit 7** square. Repeat to make (24) **Unit 7** squares total.



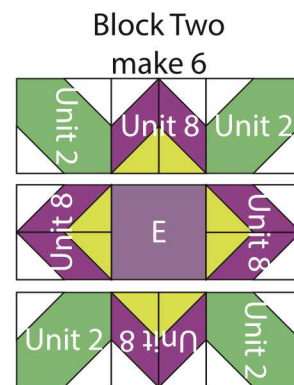
10. Sew (1) **Unit 4** strip to the left side of (1) **Unit 6** strip lengthwise to make (1) 4-1/2" **Unit 8** square. Repeat to make (24) **Unit 8** squares total.



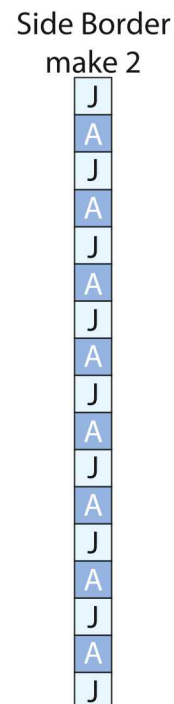
11. Sew (1) **Unit 1** square to each side of (1) **Unit 7** square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) **Unit 7** square to each side of (1) **A** 4-1/2" square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12-1/2" **Block One** square. Repeat to make (6) **Block One** squares total.



12. Repeat **Step 11** and refer to the diagram for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) **Block Two** squares.



13. Sew together (9) **J** 3-1/2" squares and (8) **A** 3-1/2" squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make (1) **Side Border**. Repeat to make a second **Side Border**.



14. Sew together (8) **A** 3-1/2" squares and (7) **J** 3-1/2" squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the **Top Border**. Repeat to make the **Bottom Border**.

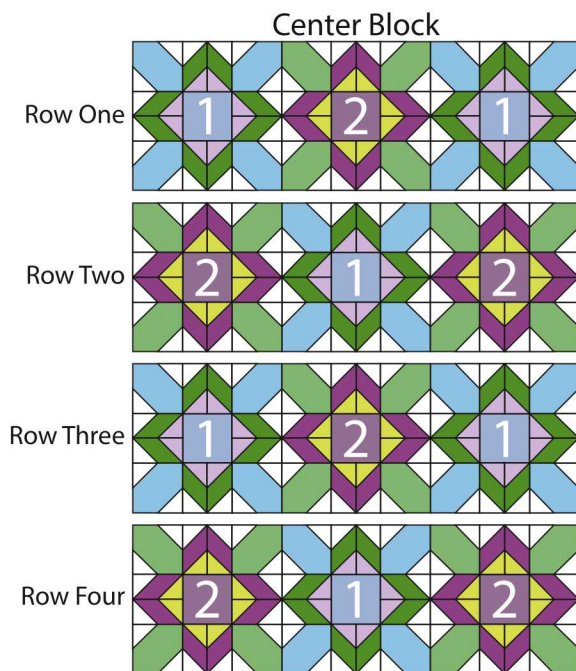


QUILT ASSEMBLY

15. Sew (1) **Block One** square to each side of (1) **Block Two** square to make **Row One**. Repeat to make **Row Three**.

16. Sew (1) **Block Two** square to each side of (1) **Block One** square to make **Row Two**. Repeat to make **Row Four**.

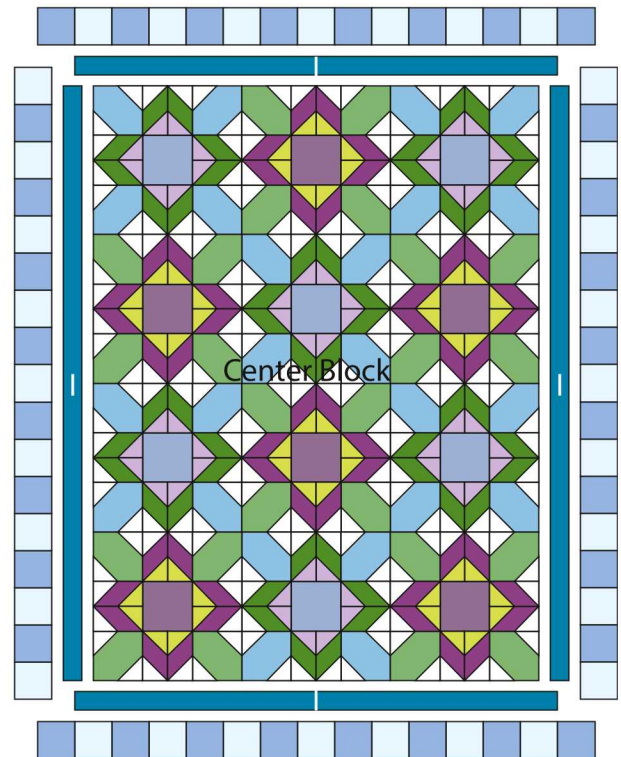
17. Sew together the (4) **Rows**, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 36-1/2" x 48-1/2" **Center Block**.



FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

BORDER ASSEMBLY *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE 1 BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

18. Sew (1) 1 2" x (48-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) 1 2" x (39-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

19. Sew (1) **Side Border** to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew the **Top Border** and the **Bottom Border** to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.
