
CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern	
1 FQ	(9) 4-1/2″ x 6-1/2″ rectangles
1/2 YD	(3) 4-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (18) 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
1 FQ	(9) 4-1/2″ x 6-1/2″ rectangles
1 FQ	(9) 4-1/2″ x 6-1/2″ rectangles
2 YDS	(12) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (180) 2-1/2" squares (7) 1-1/2" x WOF strips *, BORDER
5/8 YD	(4) 4-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (24) 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
3/8 YD	(2) 4-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (12) 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
1 FQ	(9) 4-1/2″ x 6-1/2″ rectangles
1 FQ	(9) 4-1/2″ x 6-1/2″ rectangles
3/4 YD	(5) 4-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (27) 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
1 FQ	(9) 4-1/2″ x 6-1/2″ rectangles
1 FQ	(9) 4-1/2″ x 6-1/2″ rectangles

BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all E 2-1/2'' squares.
- Place E 2-1/2" square right sides together in the top left corner of (1) A 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle (take note of direction of diagonal line). Sew on drawn line, then trim 1/4" seam allowance and press open to complete BLOCK A1. Square to 4-1/2" x 6-1/2", make (3).
- Repeat step 2 placing E square on top right corner of A rectangle (take note of direction of diagonal line) to create BLOCK A2. Square to 4-1/2" x 6-1/2", make (6).

BLOCK ASSEMBLY (continued): Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

- Repeat steps 2 and 3 to make additional blocks using E squares and B, C, D, H, J, K, L and M rectangles. Square all to 4-1/2" x 6-1/2", make number indicated.
- 5. As in step 2, sew E squares to top left and bottom right corners of F rectangles to create BLOCK F1 and BLOCK F2. Square to $4-1/2'' \times 6-1/2''$, make (12) each.
- Repeat step 5 using E squares and G rectangles to create BLOCK G1 and BLOCK G2. Square to 4-1/2" x 6-1/2", make (6) each.

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

- 7. Sew BLOCKS together into rows, then sew rows together.
 - ROWS1, 5, 9: B1-B2-L1-L2-H1-H2-J1-J2-D1-D2-B1-B2 ROWS 2, 6, 10: B2-F1-F2-L1-H2-G1-G2-J1-D2-F1-F2-B1 ROWS 3, 7, 11: K1-F2-F1-C2-K1-G2-G1-A2-M1-F2-F1-K2 ROW 4, 8, 12: K2-K1-C2-C1-K2-K1-A2-A1-M2-M1-K2-K1

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements. Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

8. Sew (1) E $1-1/2'' \times (72-1/2'')$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) E $1-1/2'' \times (50-1/2'')$ to the top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with E fabric. Note: If this Benartex pattern is included in a kit, any questions about the kit should be addressed to the vendor from whom you bought it.


