
- 1. Cut all 6" squares in half diagonally to create HSTs. Note—you will have leftover C and D HSTs to save for another project.
- 2. Sew (1) A HST and (1) C HST together to create AC UNIT. Press seam allowance open. Square to 5-1/2", make (15).
- 3. Repeat step 2 to create remaining units with fabrics shown in diagrams. Square all to 5-1/2", make number indicated.








BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS BELOW

- 4. Sew (1) each AC, AG, BD, and CG UNITS together as shown, noting rotation of each unit to create BLOCK 1. Square to 10-1/2", make (15).
- Repeat step 4 to create BLOCK 2 using units shown. Square to 10-1/2", make (15).



QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

6. Sew BLOCKS and J $1-1/2" \times 10-1/2"$ strips together into rows. Measure rows (ours are 54-1/2"), cut (5) J sashing strips to fit, then sew rows and sashing strips together.

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Rows 1, 3, 5: BLOCK 1 - J - BLOCK 2 - J - BLOCK 1 - J - BLOCK 2 - J - BLOCK 1
Rows 2, 4, 6: BLOCK 2 - J - BLOCK 1 - J - BLOCK 2
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BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements. Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

7. Sew (1) J $1-1/2" \times (65-1/2")$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) J $1-1/2" \times (56-1/2")$ strip to top and bottom.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with J fabric.
