






## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

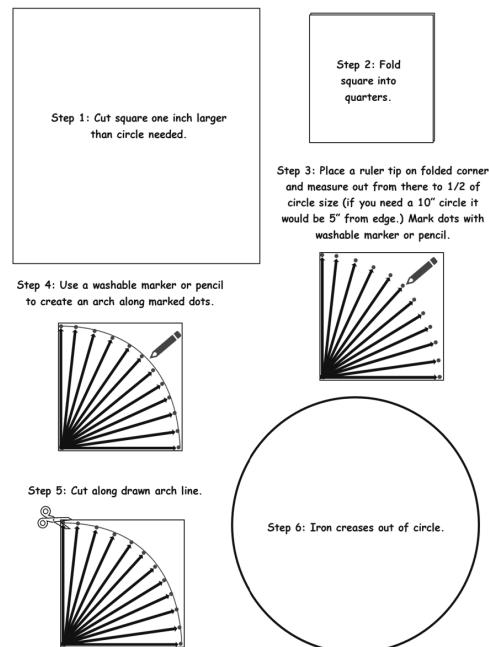
WOF = Width of fabric | \*Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED: Heat n Bond Lite Iron-on Adhesive or Heat n Bond Lite EZ Print Sheets

	<b>B ROUNABOUT</b> 16181-55 Blue/Multi	2/3 YD	(5) 4" x WOF strips *, <b>BORDER 3</b>
	<b>C FEATHERLY</b> 16182-33 Gold	2/3 YD	(4) Large Flowers for Applique
	<b>D FEATHERLY</b> 16182-54 Blue	1/2 YD	(5) 2-1/4" x WOF strips *, <b>BINDING</b>
	<b>E COLOUR PRISM</b> 16183-26 Fuchsia	1/3 YD	(4) Small Flowers for Applique
	<b>F COLOUR PRISM</b> 16183-39 Flame	1/8 YD	(4) 2" Circles for Applique
	<b>G COLOUR PRISM</b> 16183-84 Turquoise	1 YD	(2) 16" x WOF strips, subcut (4) 16" squares From remainder: Cut (4) 3" circles for Applique
	<b>H DESTINY SWIRL</b> 16184-04 Light Lime	1 YD	(4) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips and (2) 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips, <b>BORDER 2</b> (4) 12" Circles for Applique
	<b>J DESTINY SWIRL</b> 16184-06 Light Lilac	1/4 YD	(4) 4" Circles for Applique
	<b>K RADIANCE MEDALLION</b> 16185-25 Fuchsia/Multi	5/8 YD	(2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (1) 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" strip and (2) 2-1/2" x 15-1/2" strips, <b>SASHING</b> (4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" strips and (2) 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips, <b>BORDER 1</b>

### PREPARE APPLIQUE PIECES:

- You will need (4) H 12" circles and (4) A 11" circles. See diagram at right for instructions on cutting large circles.
- Trace all remaining applique designs on smooth side of iron-on adhesive. *Note: Before tracing, tape sections together if indicated by arrows. Be sure to write the letter of piece on traced designs. Designs are reversed so they will be the correct direction when ironed on fabrics.*



**BLOCK ASSEMBLY:** Refer to **BLOCK DIAGRAM** and **FLOWER KEY**

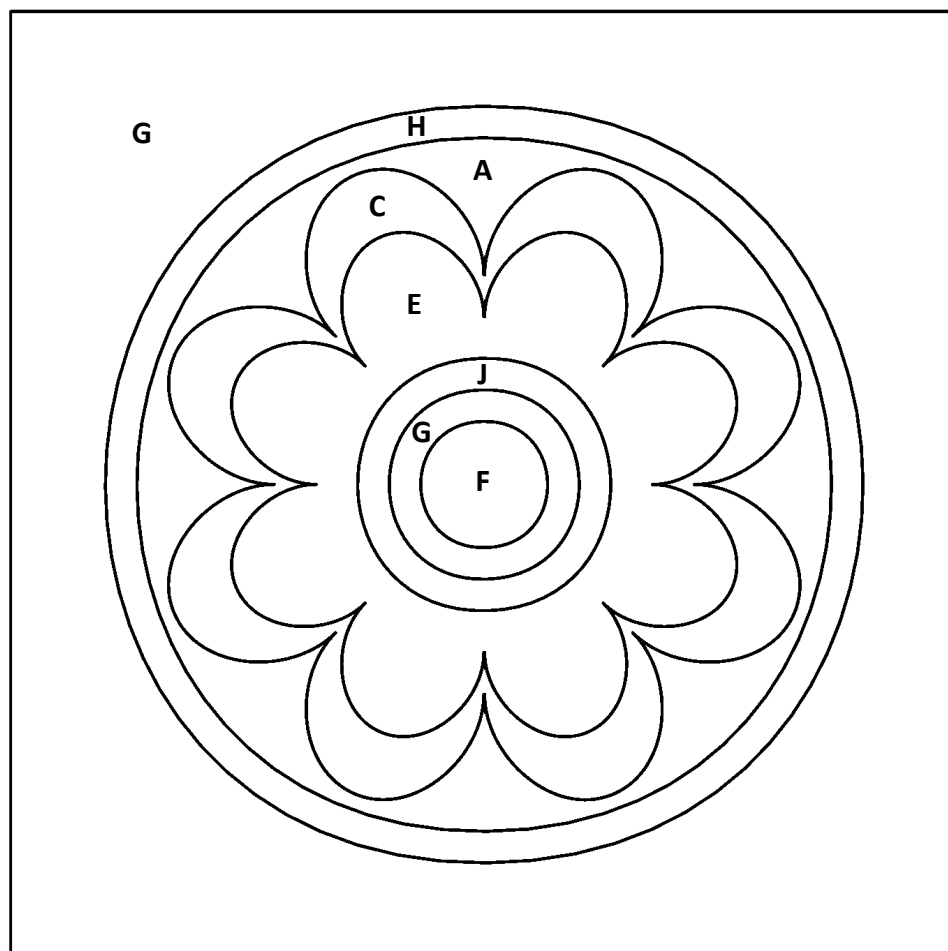
**BLOCK DIAGRAM**

3. Cut around traced applique designs leaving at least a quarter inch from solid line. *Hint: Writing the desired fabric color on the paper applique piece can avoid confusion when ironing to fabric. Iron applique designs (rough side down) to wrong side of fabrics following package directions. Let cool.*
4. Cut out applique pieces on solid lines. Peel off paper liner from the backs of applique pieces. Follow design keys for correct placement. Place applique, adhesive side down, centered on G 16" squares. Press according to package directions until entire piece is bonded. Let cool.
5. Sew around applique design edges using a straight, zig-zag, or blanket stitch. Square to 15-1/2", make (4).

**APPLIQUE TIP:** When putting together your applique pieces, lay them out first before ironing to your fabric. Make sure they slightly overlap if indicated in the key. A heatproof sheet is a great tool for assembling the pieces. Lay them out on the sheet and lightly press them in place (do not do it for too long.) Let cool. Carefully peel off the applique from the sheet and lay it on the right side of your fabric. Press in place.



**FLOWER KEY**



**QUILT ASSEMBLY:** *Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.*

6. Sew (2) BLOCKS and (1) K  $2\text{-}1/2'' \times 15\text{-}1/2''$  strip together to form rows, make (2).
7. Sew rows together with (1) K  $2\text{-}1/2'' \times 32\text{-}1/2''$  strip.

**BORDER ASSEMBLY:** *Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.*

8. Sew (1) K  $2\text{-}1/2'' \times (32\text{-}1/2'')$  strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) K  $2\text{-}1/2'' \times (36\text{-}1/2'')$  to top and bottom.
9. Sew (1) H  $1\text{-}1/2'' \times (36\text{-}1/2'')$  strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) H  $1\text{-}1/2'' \times (38\text{-}1/2'')$  to top and bottom.
10. Sew (1) B  $4'' \times (38\text{-}1/2'')$  strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) B  $2\text{-}1/2'' \times (45\text{-}1/2'')$  to top and bottom.

### **FINISHING:**

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with D fabric.

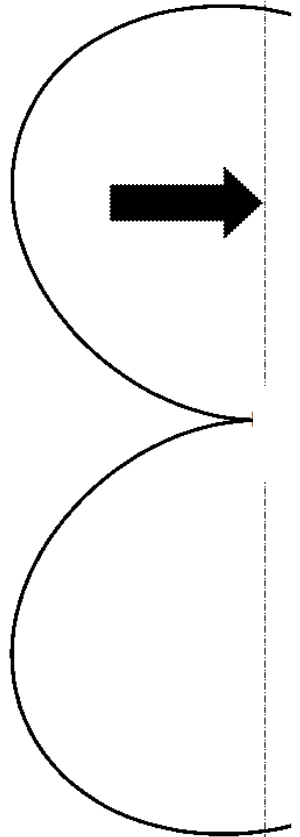
**Large Flower (C)**

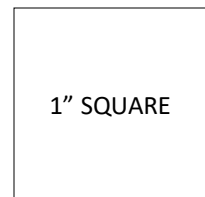

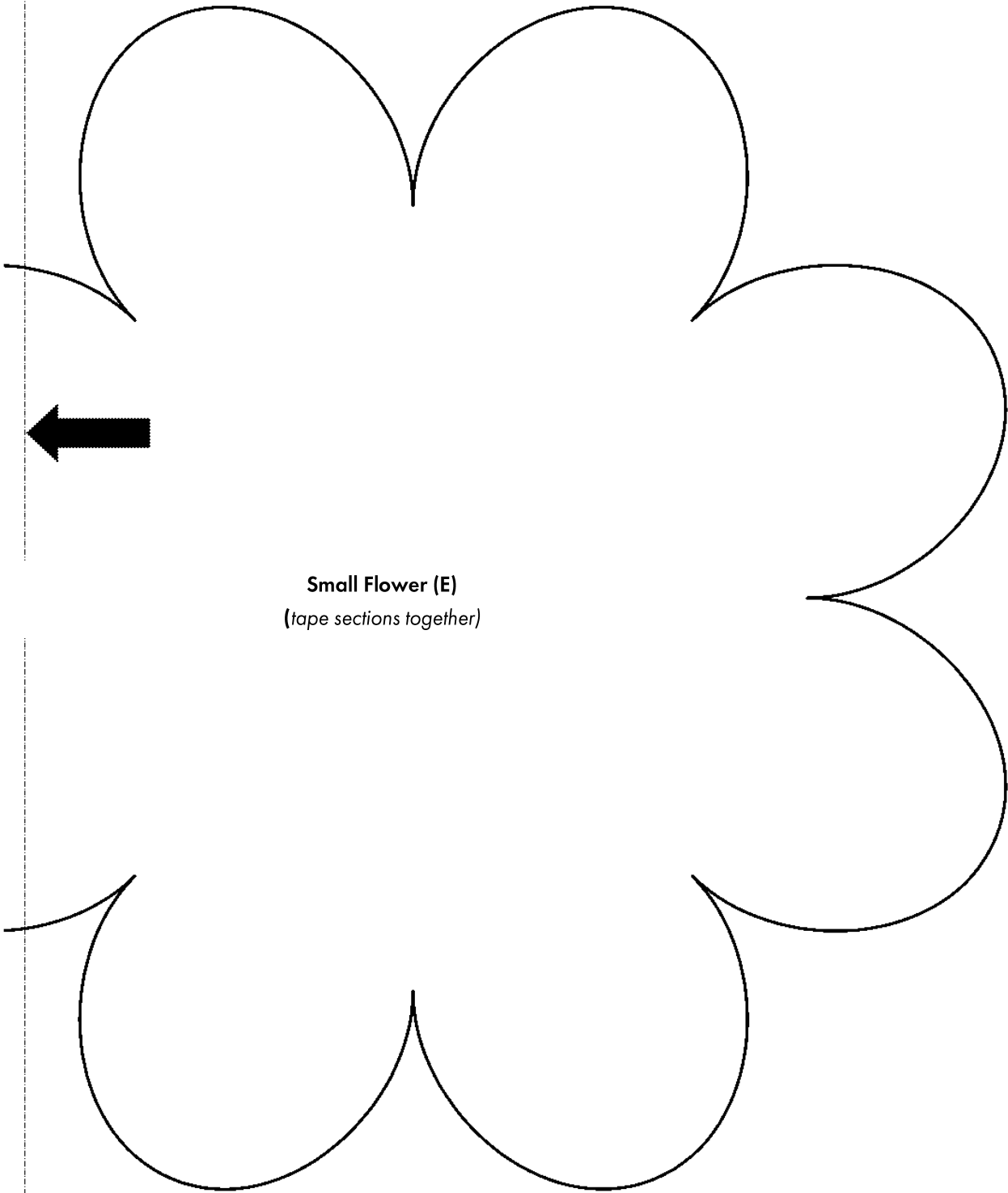
