## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric $\mid$ LOF $=$ Length of fabric $\left.\right|^{*}$ Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern


## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all $\mathbf{J} 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
2. Place (1) J 5-1/2" square right sides together with (1) K 5-1/2" square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on either side of diagonal line, then cut on drawn line. Press open and square to $5^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make (36) UNIT 1.
3. Lay out (4) UNIT 1 into (2) rows of (2). Sew into rows and join the rows to make (1) BLOCK 1. Repeat to make (9) BLOCK 1, measures 9-1/2" square.
4. Sew (1) J QST to (1) K QST along short edges, noting orientation. Repeat to make (64) UNIT 2.
5. Sew (2) UNIT 2 to opposite sides of (1) A 6-7/8" square. Add (2) UNIT 2 to remaining sides. Trim to $9-1 / 2$ " square. Repeat to make (4) Block 2A.

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.
6. Lay out the blocks and 12 H QSTs into (7) diagonal rows as shown. Sew into rows and join the rows.

ROW 1: H 14" QST - BLOCK 2B-H 14" QST
ROW 2: H 14" QST - BLOCK 2C - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2F - H 14" QST
ROW 3: H 14" QST - BLOCK 2D - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2G - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2E-H 14" QST
ROW 4: BLOCK 2A - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2E - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2B - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2G
ROW 5: H $14^{\prime \prime}$ QST - BLOCK 2A - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2C - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2A - H 14 " QST
ROW 6: H 14" QST - BLOCK 2D - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2A - H 14" QST
ROW 7: H 14" QST - BLOCK 2F - H 14" QST
7. Sew (1) H 7-1/4" HST to each of the (4) corners to complete the quilt center.
8. Trim the quilt center $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ past block points on all sides.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements.
Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.
9. Sew H 5" $\times\left(51-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew H 5" $\times\left(60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

FINISHING:
Cut batting and backing $3^{\prime \prime}$ larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with $\mathbf{H}$ fabric.
