

WOF = Width of fabric | LOF = Length of fabric | *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (26) K 5" squares, (36) **K** 3" squares, (72) **K** 2-1/2" squares and (48) **J** 4-1/2" squares.
- Lay (1) marked K 5" square right sides together with (1) J 5" square. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line, cut on the line, and press units open. Trim to measure 4-1/2" square. Make (36) **UNIT 1A**. In the same way, make (16) **UNIT 1B** using **F** 5" squares.
- Repeat step 2 using marked **K** 3" squares and 3" **E** squares. Trim to measure 2-1/2" square, make (72) UNIT 1C.
- Lay out (4) UNIT 1B, (3) C 4-1/2" squares and (2) K 4-1/2" squares into (3) rows of (3). Sew together into rows and join the rows to make **BLOCK 1**, measures 12-1/2" square. Make 4.
- 5. Noting orientation, position a marked J 4-1/2" square right sides together on the left end of (1) \mathbf{K} 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle. Stitch on the line, trim seam allowance to 1/4", and press corner open. Repeat on the opposite corner to make (1) **UNIT 2**, measuring 4-1/2" x 12-1/2". Make 24.







- 6. Sew **K** 4-1/2" squares to opposite sides of (1) **G** 4-1/2" square. Noting orientation, sew two UNIT 2 to opposite long sides to make **BLOCK 2**, measuring 12-1/2" square. Make (12).
- 7. Noting orientation, place a marked K 2-1/2" square right sides together on the upper left corner of (1) **B** 4-1/2" square. Stitch on the drawn line, trim seam allowance to 1/4", and press corner open. Repeat on the upper right corner to make UNIT 3, measures 4-1/2" square. Make (36).
- Lay out (2) UNIT 1C and 1 each H and K 2-1/2" squares into (2) rows of (2). Sew into rows and join the rows to make UNIT 4, measuring 4-1/2" square. Make (36).
- Lay out (4) each **UNIT 3** and **UNIT 4** and (1) **A** 4-1/2" square into (3) rows of (3). Sew into rows and join the rows to complete BLOCK 3, measures 12-1/2" square. Make (9).

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Refer to **QUILT DIAGRAM** for proper placement and rotation.

10. Lay out the blocks and **B** $4-1/2" \times 12-1/2"$ rectangles into (5) **BLOCK ROWS** as shown.


BLOCK ROW 1: B - BLOCK 1 - B - BLOCK 2 - B - BLOCK 3 - B - BLOCK 2 - B - BLOCK 1 - B BLOCK ROW 2: B - BLOCK 2 - B - BLOCK 3 - B - BLOCK 2 - B - BLOCK 3 - B - BLOCK 2 - B BLOCK ROW 3: B - BLOCK 3 - B - BLOCK 2 - B - BLOCK 3 - B - BLOCK 2 - B - BLOCK 3 - B BLOCK ROW 4: B - BLOCK 2 - B - BLOCK 3 - B - BLOCK 2 - B - BLOCK 3 - B - BLOCK 2 - B BLOCK ROW 5: B - BLOCK 1 - B - BLOCK 2 - B - BLOCK 3 - B - BLOCK 2 - B - BLOCK 1 - B

- 11. Sew the blocks and rectangles into rows.
- 12. Sew together (6) UNIT 1A (noting orientation) alternating with (5) B 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles to make a sashing row. Make (6).
- 13. Sew SASHING ROWS together alternating with BLOCK ROWS to make the quilt top.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with **D** fabric.
