

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric | HST = Half Square Triangle *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern


BORDER 2 BLOCKS


- 1. Find and mark center of all sides of an A 4" square and (1) each L, D, C and H HSTs. Matching centers, sew (1) L HST to top left corner and (1) D HST to bottom right corner of (1) A 4" square. Press, then sew (1) C HST to top right corner and (1) H HST to bottom left corner. Press, and square to 5-1/2", ensuring that there is 1/4" seam allowance beyond the points of **A** square.
- 2. Using fabrics noted in QUILT DIAGRAM, repeat step 1 to create remaining BORDER 1 BLOCKS. Square all to 5-1/2", make (32).


BORDER 3 BLOCKS

- 3. Sew (1) L HST and (1) D HST together. Square to 3", make (9).
- 4. Using chart on next page, repeat step 3 to create remaining BORDER 3 BLOCKS. Square all to 3", make number indicated.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements. Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

5. Sew (1) E 1-3/4" \times (43") strip to each side of **B** 22-1/2" \times 43" panel, then sew (1) E 1-3/4" \times (25-1/2") strip to top and bottom. Quilt Center should measure 25-1/2" \times 45-1/2".

NOTE: Layout all BORDER 2 and BORDER 3 blocks on a design wall to ensure proper placement before sewing together.

- 6. Sew (9) BORDER 2 BLOCKS together, then sew to left side. Repeat on right side.
- 7. Sew (7) BORDER 2 BLOCKS together, then sew to top. Repeat on bottom.
- 8. Sew (22) BORDER 3 BLOCKS together, then sew (1) E 1-1/2" x (55-1/2") strip to right (light) side, then sew to left side of quilt.
- 9. Sew (22) BORDER 3 BLOCKS together, then sew (1) E 1-1/2" x (55-1/2") strip to left (light) side, then sew to right side of quilt.
- 10. From E 1-1/2" pieced strip, cut (4) 1-1/2" x 3" pieces.
- 11. Sew (16) BORDER 3 BLOCKS and (2) E 1-1/2" x 3" strips together, then sew (1) E 1-1/2" x (42-1/2") strip to bottom (*light*) side, then sew to top of quilt.
- 12. Sew (16) BORDER 3 BLOCKS and (2) E 1-1/2" x 3" strips together, then sew (1) E 1-1/2" x (42-1/2") strip to top (light) side, then sew to bottom of quilt.
- 13. Sew (1) E $1-1/2'' \times (62-1/2'')$ strip to each side then sew (1) E $1-1/2'' \times (44-1/2'')$ strip to top and bottom.

FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with E fabric.
